

Why a "Two State Solution" is No Solution to the Middle East Crisis

We sincerely and strongly urge all who read this open letter, as of December 21st, 2023, to stand against any support of a so-called "Two-State Solution" for the Middle East. Simply put, a Two-State Solution would deliver to Islamic States both the strategic and tactical position they need to overwhelm Israel and to push Israel into the Mediterranean Sea. A Two-Party State, therefore, would place the existence of the State of Israel in severe jeopardy that she has not seen since 1948. Some fifty-eight (58) known Islamic terrorist organizations worldwide yearn for the destruction of Israel and the annihilation of the Jewish people. This includes a new organization created by Hamas within Lebanon on November 2023: "Vanguards of the Al Aqsa Flood."

All people of moral conscience must understand that Islam is a theology, a political ideology, and a system of law (Sharia) all wrapped up into one. Creating state boundaries is of temporary use for Islamic States. Any Islamic State, including any Palestinian State, is merely a geopolitical tool for the ruling caliph, the temporal leader under which international Islam is to unite. Under a Muslim caliph, no Jewish, Christian, or other non-Islamic state may exist.

The Baptist Zionist Public Affairs Committee Manifesto states clearly enough why any reader of this document should strongly oppose any Two-State Solution:

The One Jewish State Biblical Mandate for the Nation of Israel is the only answer to the Middle East conflict that will preserve Israel's sovereignty. Why a "Two-State Solution" is no solution to the Middle East Crisis;

- 1) We do not need another "Palestinian State" like Jordan. The so-called Palestinians and many Arab nations truly want a "One-State Solution," a "State of Palestine" only, so they can push the Jews into the Mediterranean Sea and achieve a Nazi-like "Final Solution."
- 2) The Israelites are the original "Palestinians," so named by the former Romans and later on the British during their occupations of Israel. The refugees in the West Bank and Gaza Strip are displaced people who are sadly abused, neglected, and manipulated by their own corrupt, terroristic leaders such as Hamas and the Palestinian Authority, with the cooperation of Iran and other avowed enemies of Israel. These refugees need to return and assimilate to their ancestral homelands of Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Egypt, etc. The Arab states, however, refuse to take them back, and have instead, by design, used their forsaken people as regional pawns. Israel is not an "Apartheid State." Israel is the only Jewish State and the only real democracy in the Middle East.
- 3) Judea and Samaria (aka the West Bank), Gaza Strip, Sinai Peninsula, and the Golan Heights are all part of the land that was promised by God to Israel.
