

Dance Class Etiquette

1. No Gum or Candy In Class.
2. No soda pop allowed in classrooms.
3. Students must wear proper dance attire. No baggy pants, sweatshirts, tank tops, etc. Any clothing larger than 1 inch away from the body is considered too baggy. Students will NOT be allowed to participate in class if they are not properly dressed.
4. Jazz pants will not be allowed in ballet class.
5. Hair must be pulled back from face.
6. No talking while the instructor is speaking.
7. If your child is going to be absent or late to his/her class, parents should call the studio.
8. Students who are more than 20 minutes tardy to class will sit and watch, unless pre-excused.
9. Parents are welcome to watch classes from the lobby.
10. Students will be expected to behave respectfully and politely towards teachers and other students.
11. No destructive or malicious behavior will be tolerated towards teachers, other students, or property.
12. No student is allowed to leave the classroom without permission.
13. Absolutely NO CELL PHONES on During class.
13. Work hard, Have Fun.

Following these guidelines will make all of the classes more enjoyable and safer for everyone.

Dress Code for Dance Class- **Students that are not properly dressed will not be allowed to participate in class.**

Students must have colors listed for the Holiday Program but may wear other colors to class. Students are NOT allowed to wear clothing over their leotards during class but may wear either a black turtleneck under their leotard or a wrap dance sweater or fitted body warmer. This is so that we can better check body alignment while they are dancing.

PS Combo Class (Ballet/Tap/Tumbling)

Leotard - Black, Tights - (Ballet Pink for show), Bike shorts or leggings may be worn to class., Black Tap Shoes, Pink leather Ballet Slippers

Combination Class (Ballet & Tap)

Leotard - Black. Tights - (Ballet Pink for show), Bike shorts or leggings may be worn to class., Tan Tap Shoes, Pink leather Ballet Slippers

Jazz & Tap Combination

Leotard - Black, Tights - (Tan for show), Bike shorts, leggings, or jazz pants may be worn to class., Tan Jazz shoes, Tan Tap Shoes

Jazz or Hip hop

Leotard - Black, Tights - (Tan for show), Tank top-snug fitting, bike shorts, leggings or jazz pants may be worn to class. Tan Jazz Shoes
(Hip Hop – Black Shoes)

Tap

Leotard - Black, Tights - (Tan for show), Tank top-snug fitting, bike shorts, leggings or jazz pants may be worn to class. Tan Tap Shoes (Girls)

Ballet

Leotard - Black Tights - (Ballet Pink for show), Unitard, bike shorts or leggings (NO Jazz Pants), Pink leather or canvas Ballet Slippers

Tumbling

Black unibike or black leotard and black bike shorts

Dress Code for Boys- Boys are to wear black dance pants and either a white turtleneck or polo shirt for the recital program. For classes they must wear Dance pants, close fitting sweatpants or shorts and a T-shirt that is not baggy. Attire should not be looser than 2 inches from the body. Tap shoes - black leather oxford with nonskid rubber, Jazz shoes - black/tan slip-on , Ballet slippers - black leather, Hip hop shoes - Black
