Dear Parents and Students;

It's hard to believe that another summer is almost over and it is time to return to dance. I hope that all of you had a safe and enjoyable break. All students that participated in the 2021 Spring Recital are invited to ride on our Danish Festival Float. Lineup will be at the Greenville High School Parking Lot at 10:00 a.m. The parade will start at 11 a.m. on Saturday August 20, 2022. Make sure that you bring a bottle of water if it's hot, and a compact umbrella if it looks like rain. The Dancimation Performing Company will be doing a performance at Danish Festival on Friday August 19th on the Main Stage at 1:20 p.m. The stage is at a new location on the corner of M 57 and S Lafayette Streets. The address is 313 S Lafayette St. Please come out and support your classmates.

This year we will be offering classes in Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary, Clogging, Tumbling, Hip Hop, Musical Theater, Sizzlin' Salsa and Ballroom for ages 2 1/2 through adult. Competition classes are also available. Our rates for group lessons are as follows:

Group Classes: (4 or more people in a class) 1st Student in Family/1st Hour Class - \$49.00 per month, 2nd Student in Family/2nd Hour Class - \$45.00 additional, 3rd Student In Family/ 3rd Hour Class - \$40.00 additional,

Semi Private: (2-3students/1 hr class) **Off prime time** (2-4, or 8 pm time slots) - \$77.00 per person, **Prime time** (5,6 or 7 pm time slots) - \$97.00 per person,

Private Class: (1 student/1 hr class) **Off prime time** (2-4, or 8 pm time slots) - \$99.00 per month, **Prime time** (5,6 or 7 pm time slots) - \$125.00 per month.

There is a small increase in tuition per month this year due to rising costs of operation. This is the first rate increase we have had since 2017. We strive to keep great dance education affordable for families and so we encourage you to participate in the fundraising opportunities we provide in the fall and spring. Classes will continue to be 55 minutes long . At this time there will be no masks required however that may change due to the different variants. Though masks are not required at this time if you would like your child to wear a mask they are certainly welcome to do so as the CDC is still encouraging non vaccinated people to wear masks. We will be allowing parents to stay in the studio room/hallway to watch classes during the 1st week of each month which is also when payments are due. Parents will be able to sit in the lobby during the remaining weeks of the month. At this time we will no longer be doing health checks so we ask that if your child has a temperature, is ill, or has been exposed to someone with Covid-19 you **DO NOT BRING THEM TO CLASS**. We also ask that if you or any member of your family tests positive for Covid-19 or is exposed to Covid-19 you notify us immediately for contact tracing purposes.

If you would like to pre-pay for the full 2022-2023 season in advance you will receive 5% off your

yearly fees and a "Miss Dee's School of Dance" dance bag free. All fees are Non-refundable. Senior Citizens 65 years and older will receive a discount of 5% off their classes. Afternoon pre-school classes are available based upon interest. If you are interested in any of these special classes please note it on your enrollment form.

Please fill out the enclosed Enrollment Form and Hold Harmless/Payment Agreement Form and mail it to the studio or call us early to get the class(es) you are most interested in. Be sure to join us for open enrollment on Aug 25 and Sept 1, 2022 from 4-7 p.m. Please include a check for \$20.00 for each class that you are registering for to reserve your spot in that class. This deposit will be deducted from your first month fees. If you do not come to class the deposit is non-refundable. Our 37th season will be starting classes Monday September 19, 2022. As we are starting classes half way through September you will only be billed for 1/2 of the month. I look forward to seeing you at Danish Festival and the enrollment open houses.
