- Ecclesiastical endorsement
- Three years fire chaplain experience
- Currently affiliated with a fire department
- FFC Essentials
- ICISF Critical Incident Stress Management
 - o Assisting Individuals in Crisis
 - o Group Crisis Intervention
- ICS Courses
 - o 100 – Introduction to the Incident Management System
 - o 200 – Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response
