<p>Area Assembly</p> <p>Eligible voting members: Group Representatives (or their alternate if absent). Only one vote per group is allowed. Every member has a voice.</p> <p>The Area Assembly is the business meeting where the groups send their representatives to express a voice and vote on behalf of the group. During an Assembly, the Delegate reports the activities of the World Service Conference. An election is held every three years to elect a Delegate and other officers. (<i>Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual</i>, page 67 and 154)</p>	<p>Area World Service Committee (AWSC)</p> <p>Eligible voting members: District representatives (or their alternate if absent), Area Coordinators, Past Delegates, AIS/LDC Liaisons, Elected Officers (except Chairperson). Every member has a voice.</p> <p>AWSC Meetings are attended by the Assembly officers, all District Representatives, Al-Anon Information Service Liaisons, and the Area Coordinators of special services. At these meetings, the Assembly agenda is planned, information and reports are conveyed, and decisions may be made that cannot wait until the next Assembly.
