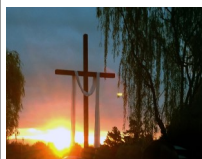
Following the egg hunt we will be opening up "Stations of the Cross" to anyone (in the family life center beginning at 6:45 p.m.). The youth will be helping with this event.
