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IT'S A TEAM SPORT

After reflection, I was reminded of two really important things. The first is that Christianity, that our faith, that Kingdom work, that the Kingdom of God is a team sport. We all have our individual faith, individual gifts, and individual callings, but they work best and to their fullest when combined with the faith, gifts, and callings of our other brothers and sisters in Christ.

We are meant to study, serve, and worship together. In fact, we NEED each other to accomplish the mission of the church. To take it a step further, we NEED each other to accomplish the Great Commission. It's a team sport.

The second thing that is important to remember, is that we are meant to pass what we have on to the next person. Like many team sports, the success of a team is often associated with how well they pass. Pass, pass, pass until you have the best opportunity to score.

We aren't meant to just receive the Gospel and keep it. Nobody likes playing with a ball hog. We are meant to receive it, capitalize on the position, and then either pass it on to the next person or score. We receive the Gospel, build our relationship with God, and then pass it on to the next person. The more we do this, as a team, the more the Kingdom of God expands and reaches those who don't have a personal relationship with God. We play our individual part, but ultimately, it is a team sport... if it is done well!
