### SACRIFICE AND ROOFS

This past Sunday, we spent some time in Genesis talking about the sacrifice that Abraham was preparing to take when he walked up that mountain with Isaac. We were challenged to consider the fact that following and living for God means that we will all have to make some sacrifices from time to time. Big and small.

Leading up to worship, several people came up to me making jokes about the rain and preaching about the Ark. I assured them that I was preaching from Genesis, but not that story. Man, did we have some serious rain on Sunday? And not just Sunday, we had some good storms throughout the week.

I want to thank all of you who have given to the roof project for the FLC. That is a sacrifice that you are making so that the church can remain a place where ministry happens. The upkeep of our facilities is so very important so that we can continue to reach and minister to our congregation and neighbors.

Because of your sacrifices, we have raised over half (about \$85,000) the funds needed to replace the roof. On Sunday evening, the session voted and approved for the Building and Grounds Committee to choose from the bids that they are receiving this week to complete the project. We don't feel that we can wait any longer, especially with the summer storms that we have and will continue to experience during this season.

Isn't that good news? Thank you for your sacrifices and donations.

I do, however, have something else to ask of you! We approved to start and continue the project with the understanding that we still need to raise the funds for the remainder of the expenses. We will share, once we have the official cost, the exact number with you later, but I want to encourage you to continue to make your sacrifices and donations. We will continue to raise funds for the roofing project, until it is paid for.

Sunday, I asked what you were willing to sacrifice to follow and grow closer to God. Maybe it is time to serve, maybe it is your life into a calling, and maybe it is resources to help continue the ministry of the church. Whatever it may be, I want to encourage you in that journey and remind you not to fret, because the Lord always provides!
