President's Day - not going there. Nope.

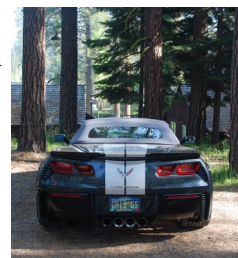

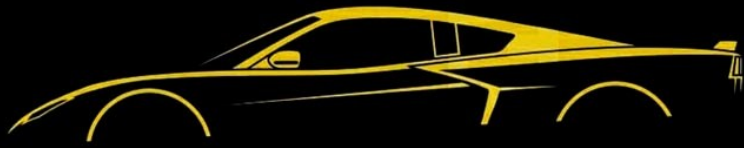

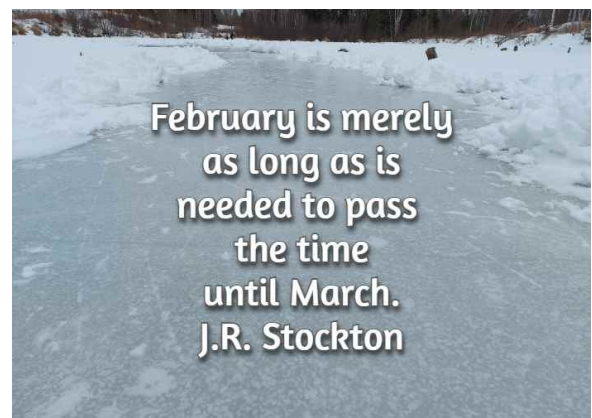
How long does it take for an envelope addressed to the Post Office to travel through the USPS system from North Eugene to South Eugene?

National Corvette Museum News

New Collections Facility

A new 66,000-square-foot collections facility is under construction on the Museum campus. When completed in 2026, the building will provide dedicated space for long-term storage, vehicle preservation, and artifact conservation. Beginning in early 2027, the facility will also serve as an educational setting where visitors can take guided tours of the facility and witness firsthand how the Museum cares for its growing collection.

New Exhibition: Driven To Preserve

Opening March 12, 2026, Driven to Preserve is rooted in the Museum's mission to collect, preserve, and share the legacy of America's Sports Car. The exhibition highlights the methods, decisions, and values that guide the Museum's stewardship of its collection. More than a dozen rarely seen Corvettes and interpretive displays will showcase how staff manage the movement of vehicles, catalog objects, and care for rare materials in a way that aligns with museum standards. Vehicles on view will include a 2003 Corvette Z06 Callaway, a 2006 Corvette Z06 Lingenfelter Twin Turbo, and a 2011 Corvette ZR1.

C8 Corvette ZR1 Named Road & Track's 2026 Performance Car of the Year Since the event's inception in 2014, no car has been named *Road & Track's Performance Car of the Year* more times than the Chevrolet Corvette .

Chevy Corvette Receive J.D. Power 2026 Canada ALG Residual Value Awards The iconic Chevy Corvette has secured a key victory in the realm of long-term value, earning a J.D. Power 2026 Canada ALG Residual Value Award. The hallowed sports car topped the Midsize Premium Sporty Car segment, a recognition that forecasts its exceptional ability to retain value over time.

The two colors, Riptide Blue and Hysteria Purple will be phased out in 2026. GM had considered combining the two colors and calling it "Burple" but was overruled by common sense.

The 2026 Corvette Stars & Steel Edition Will Cost \$10,000.00 additional . The Stars & Steel Limited Edition will be offered across the entire C8 Corvette family, including the C8 Stingray, C8 Z06, C8 E-Ray, C8 ZR1, and even the new C8 ZRIX. Buyers will be able to choose from either a coupe or convertible body style, though availability is restricted to the top-tier 3LT and 3LZ trim levels. (From Corvette Blogger)

Corvette Engine Build Experience Will Return In 2026, giving owners the opportunity to personally assemble the heart of their new C8. General Motors last offered the program during the 2019 model year for the C7-generation Z06 and ZR1 .Essentially, the program will allow participants to assemble their own engine for a hands-on, factory-backed experience. Participants will be able to assemble either the 5.5L V8 LT6 (Z06) or twin-turbo 5.5L V8 LT7 (ZR1, ZRIX) engine, depending on the vehicle ordered. No price point has been established. Previously on the C7 build it cost the participant \$5000.00.
