The "Dog Days" of summer are generally acknowledged to be from July 3 to August 11 each year. They are usually the hottest and most unbearable days of the year. We often hear about the dog days of summer but few know where the expression originated. Some think it's a reference to the hot sultry days that are not fit for a dog. Others think it's the heat that drives dogs mad. Surprisingly the answer is in the



The phrase is a reference to Sirius the Dog Star. During the "Dog Days" period the sun occupies the same region in the sky as Sirus which is the brightest star visible from any part of earth. Sirius is part of the constellation Canis Major, the Greater Dog. The myth behind Sirius is that he is the loyal dog of the hunter Orion. In the summer, Sirius rises and sets with the sun. On

July 23, specifically, it is in conjunction with the sun, and because the star is so bright, ancient Romans and Greeks believed it gave off heat and added to the sun's warmth. This accounted for the long stretch of sultry weather. They referred to this time as "dog days". So, the phrase Dog Days of summer came to mean the 20 days before and 20 days after this alignment of Sirius with the sun – July 3 to August 11 each year.

Well, there you have it... the dog belongs to Orion according to myth, and we can ponder this as we sip our ice-cold beverages and wait for the sun to go down.


