During the 70's & 80's one of the most popular Corvette events in the West was V&T in Reno, Nevada. V&T took it's initials from the Virginia & Truckee Railroad which was a mining and logging train running in the Reno & Lake Tahoe area.

Held at various casinos in Reno it quickly became a "partying" destination for Corvette clubs. A road trip up and over Mt. Rose on the way to Lake Tahoe as well as circle tours around Lake Tahoe was a highlight.

What we learned at The Bash 2022

1. The 2023 ZO6 is a legitimate, real-world, bad-ass Supercar.

a. 670 hp @ 8400 rpms, 5.5L flat-plane crank small-block V8. The highest horsepower, naturally aspirated engine ever produced.

b. Completely new DCT 8-speed transmission, re-engineered to handle the increased horsepower.

c. 0-60 in 2.6 seconds. 1/4-mile et of 10.6 @131 mph.

d. Improved steering and suspension engineering required.

e. Carbon fiber brake rotors AND wheels optional.

f. ZO6 with ZO7 (track package) generates an amazing 734 lbf of downforce.

What we don't know yet is how much this world class sports car is going to cost or when we can begin ordering. Speculation is that ordering will begin "soon" and obviously, pricing will be revealed before ordering opens.



- 2. Michelin, in conjunction with GM, has developed and will be manufacturing all new rubber for the `23 ZO6 in 285/30/20 and 345/25/21 sizes the widest tire ever on Corvettes.
- 3. Corvette now owns 51% of "market share" in the "up-scale, luxury sports car" market. More than all other marques <u>combined</u> !

4. Mobil 1 has "re-branded" the new for 2019 0W-40 ESP motor oil. To reduce confusion between ESP and European Formula the correct oil for Corvettes will now be marketed as "0W-40 Supercar". Recommended motor oil for C5, C6 and `14-`18 C7's is Mobil 1 5W-30. `14-`18 may use 0W-40 with no ill-effects. 2019 C7's with drysump and all C8 models should be using 0W-40 Supercar.
