



C7 Nightmare Scenario

You're out for a cruise with your Corvette friends and you need fuel. Your friends are waiting and you pull to the pump - your fuel door won't open! The actuator has failed to withdraw the locking pin. Now what do you do?? You need to remove the painted cover of your fuel door.

It has clips that slide into place. From left to right for it to come off. Then right to left to snap it back on. It is the best way to do it without pulling the rear fender liner.

Take two credit cards, slip them in the forward gap of the fuel door (gap nearest the front of the car, or at the 9 o'clock position looking at the fuel door), insert a flat blade screwdriver between the cards so as not to nick the paint, turn the screw driver until the door pops off. Then use the screwdriver to retract the fuel door locking plunger.



OR.... You could be proactive and fix the problem before it happens. Go to your local hardware store and buy a scrivet, aka "Christmas-tree fastener" of the correct diameter and insert it into the locking hole on the backside of the fuel door.

"VOILA" no more lock-out!
