
**Springfield Cruz**

**Mobil 1 Re-labeling GM recommended oil**

Since model year 2019 the GM recommended engine oil for 2019 C7 and '20-'23 C8 has been Mobil 1 0W-40 ESP Formula Dexos2. Coincidentally, Mobil 1 also produces a 0W-40 European Formula. This has caused a lot of confusion and several botched oil changes.

To alleviate this confusion, Mobil 1 is re-naming this Corvette specific oil "Supercar". Soon the ESP Formula packaging will disappear and you will only find Supercar. It is the same oil, just a different name.

If you change your own oil & filter, look to buy or order 0W-40 Supercar. If you go to a dealership for oil changes, verify which oil they are using in your 2019-23 Corvette.
