Print these instructions for future reference and to aid in the completion of the form if desired. A small fee is added if using Pay-Pal for payment to help defray PayPal processing costs and is part of the worksheet on page 2. Include page 1 & 2 of the form with your work sheet on page 2 completed. We'll use the work sheet as a paper backup, even if you use the online store to order your shirts and pay your registration fees.

YOUR SUBMISSION OPTIONS:

- 1) A right click on the website form will allow you to print the form. Fill it out legibly. Mail with a check payable to LGCA. Electronic payment options are also available by using the VOTR online store.
- 2) Fill out the form electronically (see instructions below), print and mail with a check or use the "Store".
- 3) Whether completed manually or electronically, scan the printed form into your email program as an attachment.
- 4) Fill out the form electronically and save it. Attach the saved file to an email. Send a check or use the "Store" to pay online.

ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION & GENERAL FORM INFORMATION

These instructions are based on having a current version of "Adobe Acrobat Reader DC" installed on your computer. The display and techniques are the same on PC and Mac platforms. The software can be downloaded for free at- https://get.adobe.com/reader/

- Menu descriptions, t-shirt sizes and costs, car classes & allowed modifications, and a fee worksheet are part of the registration form. Please reference the car classes and modifications to insure you pick the correct class.
- The PDF file linked to the registration button on the LGCA website will not open initially in Acrobat Reader and cannot be altered. You <u>can</u> print it with a "right click" and send in a paper copy. If you want to continue with an electronic submission, save the document with the "disc icon" on the upper toolbar or with the "save as" option under "File" as a PDF, renaming it if you'd like. Open the saved document, and it should appear in Acrobat Reader.
- Once open in "Reader" click on the "fill & sign" or "pen" option on the right. Select "You" on the next screen. The form can now be filled in by scrolling down the page. Make sure "Ab" is displayed for text or number entries, and the "x" or checkmark to mark the box responses, selecting the correct icon in the upper tool bar. Some dialogue boxes will automatically highlight, others will require a "click". Hover just above the line for each entry, click as necessary, enter the text and move on to the next cell. If you make a mistake, just back space or select the trash icon in the blue field above the dialogue box.
- The left side of the upper tool bar shows your options. Save it to your computer for later printing or attachment to a personal email with the "disc" icon. You can also print the completed form from the current screen with the "printer" icon. Don't bother with the "Next" selection in the upper right. That generates a link to your document and requires signing into Adobe as an account holder. Use the PO Box or email address above to send in your form. Utilize your desired payment option. You are done.

2020 Show N Shine Modifications

The modification criteria attempt to allow as much leeway as possible for each owner to personalize their cars while allowing the car to compete as an unmodified entry. At some point, reason needs to prevail. We will allow four visible modifications to a car according to the following criteria. Five or more will place the car in one of the two modified classes. If a change to a car is GM certified, or is a GM OEM accessory, whether dealer, factory, or owner installed, it will not count as a modification. To be safe, reference the GM website for certified GM Corvette accessories. If the part comes with a GM sticker or part number on it, it passes muster. If the part or modification is aftermarket, it will count as a modification. Regardless, we are talking about minor cosmetic changes to enhance the car. Major changes such as fender flares and ground effects that change the exterior profile of the car, or major performance enhancements to the engine will count as modifications.

These changes will count as modifications:

EXTERIOR- spoilers and/or front fascia changes, rear or front fender/wheel well flares, rocker panel additions, wings or non-OEM rear spoilers, performance hoods, exhaust tunnel fascia treatments. Non-OEM custom paint or paint that is not model year specific, after market stripes, graphics, or lettering, either in painted or decal form. Exhaust systems significantly different than stock-a Corsa 4 tip system on a C5, C6, or C7 would not count. Custom wheels or wheel covers, non-stock painted calipers and after-market brake systems. Front or rear lighting changes.

ENGINE COMPARTMENT- colored, chrome, carbon fiber panel covers, fuel rail covers, or chrome reservoir caps. Non-OEM valve and air filter covers. Superchargers, turbos, custom intake manifolds. After-market air induction systems. Chrome belt pulleys, colored belts. Colored or braided ignition parts. Custom under hood graphics or hood blankets.

INTERIOR- colored or carbon fiber panels. Colored switches or knobs. Lettering, decals, badges. Custom seats. Colored shift and hand brake boots. Waterfall and console changes, custom carpeting.

If you have stayed true to the original model, even with a major restoration, the car should fit the stock definition. The list is not all inclusive. If you have any questions, please give me a call or send an email before completing the registration.
