
Valentine Dinner

ZR1 VIN #001 sells for \$3.7 Million at Barrett-Jackson



Once again, Rick Hendricks (NASCAR team & multiple Chevrolet dealer owner) has purchased a VIN #001 Corvette, this time the first 2025 Corvette ZR1. The entire purchase price will be donated by Barrett-Jackson to the American Red Cross to aid disaster victims.

Hendrick has an expensive Corvette VIN 001 habit. He scored the first production <u>2024 Corvette E-Ray</u> for \$1.1 million, along with the <u>first 2023 Corvette</u> <u>Z06</u> for \$3.6 million, the <u>first retail 2020</u> <u>Corvette Convertible</u> for \$400,000, and the <u>first C8 Corvette Coupe</u> \$3 million. He also placed the winning bid on <u>the first production 2019 C7 Corvette ZR1</u> way back in 2018, so his latest acquisition will fit right in with his collection.

The <u>ZR1</u> was designed to challenge the world's best <u>supercars</u> with its 5.5-liter, twin-turbocharged dual overhead cam flat -plane crank <u>LT7</u> V8 engine rated with a stunning 1,064 horsepower.

GM Really Wants You to Follow the Maintenance Schedule for Your C8 Corvette's Transmission

. The C8 Corvette's <u>dual clutch transmission</u> continues to make headlines for Chevrolet but it seems like it's for all the wrong reasons. Yes, the C8's DCT from Tremec is a marvel as it delivers lightning-fast shifts, but it's also been the one component that C8 owners have had the most issues with. In addition to these service issues, there still seems to be some confusion over the maintenance schedules, what they entail, and how they might apply to earlier C8s versus newer models years.

GM wants to help clear the air on the maintenance of the C8 transmissions, and they have recently begun sending leaders out to owners detailing when to change your transmission's oil filter. This is important to follow, as GM will reject warranty claims on the transmission if all this criteria isn't met.

The key point to remember is that GM wants to see all transmission oil filters replaced between 7,000-8,000 miles. The owner's manual states 7,500 miles, but GM gives us the leeway of 500 miles before or after that mark. The next change comes at 22,500 miles and then every additional 22,500 miles afterwards. If you had your transmission filter replaced prior to 7,500 miles, it still needs to be done again between 7,000-8,000 miles. And finally, GM reminds us that even if you have had your transmission replaced, you need to follow these guidelines so that the filter is replaced at 7,500 miles from when you received the replacement.

Here are the guidelines provided by GM:

- If you already replaced the filter before 7,000 miles (12,000 km) Replace the filter again by 8,000 miles (13,000 km)
- If you have not replaced the filter and mileage is under 7,000 miles (12,000 kmn) Replace the filter between 7,000-8,000 miles (12,000-13,000 km)
- If you have not replaced the filter and mileage is over 8,000 miles (13,000 km) Make an appointment with your dealer.
- If mileage is under 8,000 miles (13,000 km) and your vehicle is 3 or more years old Make an appointment with your dealer.

The only exception to the 7,000-8,000 mileage rule is if your Driver's Information Center (DIC) says "Replace Transmission Filter Soon."

We also believe part of the confusion stemming from the C8's transmission service is the question of who pays for it, as GM initially promised to cover that during a "First Maintenance Visit." However, many were finding they only met the time requirement for a motor oil change, but not the mileage requirement for the transmission filter change. For 2024+ Corvettes, the motor oil change and the transmission oil filter

change are now split into two separate warranty items.
