There is a lot to learn by participating in the Camille Playhouse Summer Youth Workshop, whether it be their first time on the stage or the 30th time. This program will take your child through the entire process of putting on a show: including reading through a script, auditioning, learning choreography, staging, costumes, lights, sounds, and at the end will be putting on a full weekend of performances! Our office will be contacting you via email with updates and reminders, *so please make sure the email you register with is one you check often.*

ATTENDANCE: The morning session begins at 9 AM and the afternoon session starts at 1 PM. Students should be seated in the theater before that time. If you know your child will be late or will be absent, please talk to a director beforehand or call the office.

CASTING: Students and parents, please understand that every part in the show is important. Not everyone will be cast in a lead role, but all parts are crucial to putting on the best show we can! Any of the students can audition for any part, but ultimately the part will go to the student who fits it best. The directors have the right to double cast roles, meaning your child may not play the same character for every performance. Students and parents will be made aware of the performance schedule as we have the information.

RESPECT: Students need to respect *everyone* and *everything* while participating in our summer workshop. They need to respect the art, respect the theater, respect the directors, and respect their fellow actors. This is something that the directors will be strict on enforcing. Failure to follow this rule will include calls home, being removed from scenes, or removal from the program if the directors deem it necessary. If a student is removed from the program for not following any of the rules - specified on this list or put in place by the directors- no refunds will be issued.

PICK UP: Pick up will be at the stage door at either 12 PM or 4PM depending on which session your child is in. You are welcome to wait in the lobby, but please do not interrupt the rehearsal unless it is an emergency. **Please pick up your children no later than 15 minutes after the session is complete.** If there will be a change of pickup, please speak to the director or office beforehand. Failure to comply with our pickup policy affects our schedule and curriculum for the program; multiple instances of noncompliance will result in loss of complimentary tickets. Students will not be allowed to leave the theater unattended or with anyone other than their guardian without prior notice.
