JOB DESCRIPTION

The position of Summer Youth Workshop Director allows individuals to be the lead creative for a youth musical, be part of a supportive team for 4 total shows in the summer, and to have an opportunity to experience the process of putting together a show together from the ground up. This position was created with all levels of experience in mind: from professional performance experience to students currently studying the musical arts to anyone who has experience on and off stage. We offer this position to encourage community members to be part of the Camille Playhouse process in a creative and organized educational environment.

The main responsibilities of those in the position are to be part of the creative teams for all four productions we offer in the program, to lead and educate students on the process of producing a show, encourage and establish proper theater exercises and warmups, and to be able to handle groups of students both on and off stage. A normal day of the program includes physical and vocal warmups, instructional periods for theater etiquette, music, choreography, and staging, acting exercises and games, and sections for creative work, including painting, costume, and set design. All of this aligns with the organization's mission to educate and enlighten to youth members of our community with the process of putting on a production.

We are looking for individuals who have experience in the performance and technical arts, who are looking for positions to teach youth members of the community, and those who work well on group projects. These individuals should also have experience with one or more of the following categories: stage direction, music direction, choreography direction, stagecraft, stage management, technical theater, painting, property construction, costume design and creation, and/or experience with youth members of the community in educational or artistic engagement.
