Position Details

Hours

- Position is full time (40 hours / week) from 7:30am to 3:30pm Monday to Friday, with weekly staff meetings until 4:00pm. Scheduling is flexible among the staff to support family and other outside commitments

Pay

- This is a salary position, \$38,000/year, not eligible for overtime. Pay periods are monthly and can be structured on a 10 or 12 month schedule.

Duties and Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Embodying the Montessori philosophy, displaying a deep respect and love for children.
- Maintaining a healthy, clean, and safe environment for the children in your care.
- Preparing the learning environment for the students in your classroom, under guidance from the Head of School.
- Reinforcing and modeling classroom rules and expectations.
- Redirecting children to work.
