St. Francis and St. Clare Parish is celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday on Sunday April 16 from 2:30 - 3:30pm at St Theresa's church.

This hour of adoration will include the rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

All parishioners from the Parish are welcome to attend.

Between 1930 and 1938, Christ appeared to Sister Faustina, a Sister of Mercy in Poland, who initiated the Divine Mercy devotion. On Good Friday, 1937, Jesus requested that Blessed Faustina make a special Novena before the Feast of Mercy, from Good Friday through the following Saturday. He gave her a chaplet to be recited and said that it was appropriate to pray the chaplet at three o'clock each afternoon (the Hour of Great Mercy). She was canonized on April 30, 2000, the Sunday after Easter, the Feast of Divine Mercy.

## FEAST OF ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA IN THEIR 75TH YEAR

The Feast Day of St. Catherine of Siena is April  $29^{th}$ , and the liturgy at Saturday's 9:00 am Mass at St. Catherine's will celebrate the day. We will continue to celebrate her blessings to us on **Sunday**, **April**  $30^{th}$ , at the 11:00 am Mass in St. Catherine of Siena Church. We will also celebrate our  $75^{th}$  Anniversary of the establishment of our Church community. A reception will follow. Everyone is welcome.

Catherine was born on March 25, 1347, in Siena, Italy. Many holy women achieved great status at this time of history, but Catherine was the most outstanding, not only because of the extent of her activities in her short life but because of her written legacy. Her "Letters" show evidence of the wide audience she reached with her teachings and guidance. Her "Prayers", twenty-six in total, were recorded as it was her habit to pray aloud in the presence of her followers. The "Dialogue" was just that, her dialogue between herself and God. God is the teacher in the dialogue between them.

In this dialogue, God told Catherine about His plan for us: "This is why I have put you among your neighbours: so that you can do for them what you cannot do for me - that is, love them without any concern for thanks and without looking for any profit for yourself. And whatever you do for them I will consider it done for me."
