FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY TUESDAY, AUGUST 15TH

The Feast of the Assumption of Mary recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God. Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary as the perennial teaching of the Church when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic

faith in 1950, invoking papal infallibility to proclaim, "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

- 3. Sign up for pre-authorized payments through our Parish Office.
- 4. Mail your donation to our Parish Office.

Please be assured that any donations received will be assigned to your and income tax receipts will be issued. Thank you for your continued generosity!

What are pre-authorized payments?

The Parish has a Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) plan to assist you in your support of the work of our community. It allows you to give intentionally, proportionally, and faithfully to your community by having your offering automatically withdrawn from your bank account each month.

- Convenience. No more scrambling for the right change, writing a cheque, or forgetting your envelope at home.

- Allows for regular, dependable flow of contributions to the Parish.

Celebrate Our Diocesan Feast Day

August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption - and our diocesan feast day! As we celebrate the assumption of Mary into heaven body and soul, we seek her intercession and guidance for the faithful of our whole Archdiocese.

To celebrate our feast day, Archbishop Dunn will celebrate Mass at 12 noon on August 15 at Saint Mary's Cathedral. The Mass will be followed by a BBQ in the courtyard between the church and the glebe. All are welcome!

As well during the Mass we will take up a special collection for the Daily Bread Outreach program that runs out of the Cathedral hall during the week serving food to almost 700 people each week. And the need is only growing! Many people across our Archdiocese have experienced significant hardship over the past few years, from the impact of the pandemic to the housing crisis to natural disasters. These experiences highlight the fragility of human life and that we must rely on one another in times of hardship. In honour of our feast day we invite you to consider helping those in need by donating to The Daily Bread Outreach, Thank you in advance for your generosity and support.
