
ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA BURSARY AWARDED

On May 25, 2022, an agreement was signed with the Halifax Regional Municipality for the expropriation of land they required for the widening of Bayers Road.


HRM had reported that Phase 2 construction (Connaught Avenue to Windsor Street) would take place in 2023 at the earliest. We have recently been informed that Phase 2 will not take place until 2025.



St Francis and St Clare of Assisi Parish wishes to offer a big THANK YOU to an anonymous couple who graciously contributed the cost (\$2,200) for an AED (automated external defibrillator) for St Catherine's church.

An AED is used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. It's a sophisticated, yet easy-to-use, medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock, or defibrillation, to help the heart re-establish an effective rhythm.

Although, we hope to never have to use this device, it is a gracious gift for the safety and well-being of all those who worship at this site within our Parish.

What are pre-authorized payments?

The Parish has a Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) plan to assist you in your support of the work of our community. It allows you to give intentionally, proportionally, and faithfully to your community by having your offering automatically withdrawn from your bank account each month.

- Convenience. No more scrambling for the right change, writing a cheque, or forgetting your envelope at home.
- Continued support of your Church when you are away.
- Allows for regular, dependable flow of contributions to the Parish.
- If you wish to have something to place in the collection basket, you can still receive your box of numbered envelopes. They have been pre-printed to allow you to indicate that you give through PAD.

Mass for North American Indigenous Games

At the request of members of our Mi'kmaq communities, Archbishop Dunn will offer the 12:15 Mass on Saturday, July 15 at Saint Mary's Cathedral Basilica for all involved in the North American Indigenous Games (NAIG). All are welcome!

Halifax will host the 10th NAIG from July 15-23.

There will be competitions in 16 sports within 21 venues across Kjipuktuk (Halifax), Dartmouth, Millbrook First Nation and Sipekne'katik.

NAIG 2023 will bring together more than 5,000 athletes, coaches and team staff from 756+ Indigenous Nations celebrating, sharing and reconnecting through sport and culture with the help of 3,000 volunteers.

Class Action: Claims Period

The Claims period of the class action suit filed against the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth runs from December 14, 2022 until December 14, 2023. Individuals who wish to make a claim to receive settlement benefits have 12 months in which they can make a formal claim. See notice below.

NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT IN CLASS ACTION

To all individuals who were sexually abused by a priest of the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Halifax or Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Yarmouth between April 14, 1954 and March 31, 2020 and have not previously settled or otherwise released either the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Halifax or Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Yarmouth.

The Court has approved a settlement which provides compensation to eligible class members who file a claim for sexual assault and meet the requirements of the claims process.

If you opted out of the class action, the settlement will not impact you.

If you are part of the lawsuit as a Class Member, you can submit a claim for a payment of money as compensation. The amount of money that you may receive will depend on the specifics of the claim you submit. The potential amount of money to be paid to a Class Member whose claim is accepted will likely range from \$30,000 to \$350,000.

You must submit your claim for compensation before December 14, 2023. If you do not submit your claim for compensation before December 14, 2023, you will lose your right to compensation.

Deacon Formation

Seven men have completed their diaconate discernment year and have been accepted to begin their aspirant year in September 2023, the first of a four year formation process.

Ron Chisholm and Charlie Vaughan are nearing the end of the formation process for the permanent diaconate. On June 11, Ron Chisholm's candidacy application was confirmed at a mass at Immaculate Conception Parish in Truro. Ron also was installed as lector. Charlie Vaughan was installed as acolyte June 15, 2023 at St. John XXIII church, part of Divine Mercy Parish. Bill Grady's application for ordination to the Permanent Diaconate was approved by Archbishop Dunn. Bill's ordination will take place August 10 (Feast of St. Lawrence) at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica.

We thank God for placing the call to serve on the hearts of these men and we continue to pray for them.
