I was raised in a Roman Catholic tradition as a result of my mother's faith and attended St. Joseph's Catholic Grade School from kindergarten through 6th grade, at which time I transferred to the public junior and senior high school. By the time I entered college I was an agnostic. I thought there might be a God, but I didn't really know and didn't much care.

I was doing well at school and generally enjoying life, but I started getting an empty feeling inside that came with this question about life: "Is this all there is?" In 1975, I studied in London, England for a semester and while touring St. Paul's Cathedral, I asked to see the wooden model of the church Sir Christopher Wren wanted to build after the fire of 1660. It was not on public display and an Anglican Priest took me up to the attic of the church and he said to me: "You tourists, you are all alike, you think this is a museum. It is the house of God." I kind of inwardly rolled my eyes and thought, don't preach to me, I just want to see the model. Then he continued, "That which is seen is temporal, and that which is unseen is eternal." Well, he got me there. I realized I was a shallow person. I had almost no idea or concept of anything beyond my physical senses. I started to realize that the answer to my question about life, "Is this all there is?" was beginning to be answered. I later learned that the Anglican Priest quoted the Apostle Paul, "So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."¹

I started to intensely seek the Lord. I woke up on December 21, 1975 and I knew Him. I cannot take any credit for that because I was asleep when the realization hit me. It was the greatest feeling on Earth. I felt free. It doesn't answer all of life's questions, but I no longer feel empty inside or ask the question, "Is this all there is?"

The reason I am facilitating this Bible study is that I enjoy sensing Christ in His word with others who are also sensing Christ. "For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst."²
