We really don't want you to feel obligated to attend in person if you do not feel as safe as when you go to the grocery store or restaurant. I realize that several of you have not left your house in a couple of months and I know that you may want to wait a little longer to leave the house and that is perfectly understandable and that is what you should do. Several others are in long term care and have not been able to leave for many weeks and we are thinking of you in this time as well. Please let us know if you need help with the reception of the services and we will do our best to help. This will be a "soft" regathering to work out the details how we can be the best stewards possible with your facility and your health. It will be a shorter service, 35 minutes or so in length, as we will not be passing the offering plate, meeting and greeting or singing out loud to better protect each one here. But don't worry, it will get longer when everything opens up into the next phase and we get more back to normal.
