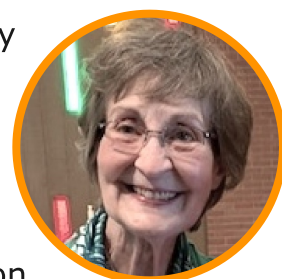

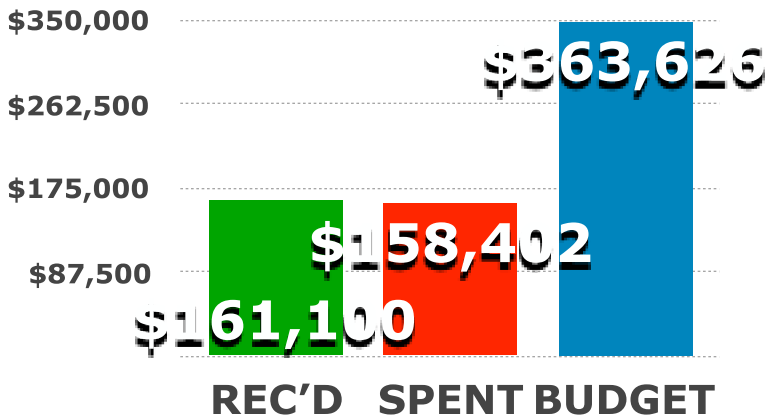
Linda had worked as an activity director at a nursing home and done volunteer work for Special Olympics.
