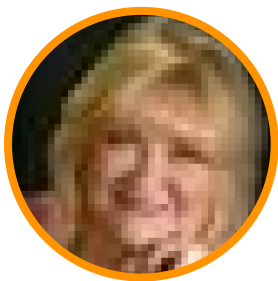


Renelda's Road to Recovery

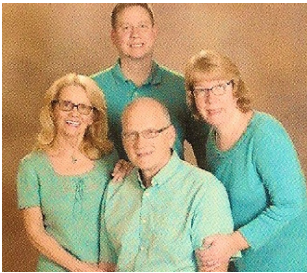
