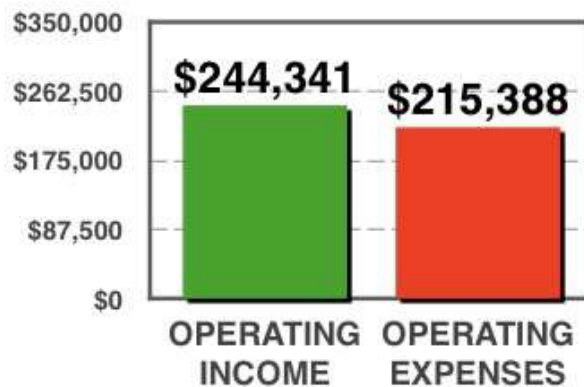
## Kaleidoscope News
