

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM CITY MAINTAINED STREETS DURING A DECLARED WINTER WEATHER EMERGENCY!

Removing vehicles from public streets during any storm event greatly helps city plow and salt trucks to clear streets faster, safer, and more efficiently.

Snowfall Guidelines

CATEGORY 1

Snowfall of less than 4 inches

Major Roads & Emergency Routes-

52.8 miles of major roads. These roads are plowed and salted on a 24 hour basis, 7 days a week, as needed.

Local Roads- 240.6 miles of local roads are plowed and treated during our normal Department hours, Monday-Friday, 7:00 am-3:30 pm

CATEGORY 2

Snowfall of 4 or more inches throughout the City

Major Roads & Emergency Routes-

52.8 miles of major roads. These roads are plowed and salted on a 24 hour basis, 7 days a week as needed.

Local Roads- 240.6 miles of local roads are plowed and treated on an as-needed basis, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. During a substantial snowfall some Primary Residential Plow Routes may be plowed before drivers begin the East/West Routes.

BEAUTIFICATION

- Entrance Signs refreshed
- Tree trimming around Crown Point Park and on Salem Court
- Sprinklers were replaced on Annchester Court
- Lawn and landscape company has been very responsive
- Ditch dredged off of Edmunton back to Hawthorn Hills Sub
- Water Leak discovered on Snowden Court
- Monticello Park is still "under water"
- Landscaping refresh on Burlington Ct and Salem Ct did not happen
