## Here are some tools and equipment to maintain a yard

After a few years a typical shed or garage might include a combination of the following items

Lawnmower,- Leaf blower,- Hedge trimmer,- Pruning shears,- Rake,- Shovel
Wheelbarrow,- Garden hose,- Pressure washer,- Chainsaw,- Pole saw,- Lawn aerator,- Lawn dethatcher
Power auger,- Post hole digger,- Wet/dry vacuum

Hammer 2. Screwdrivers (flathead and Phillips), 3. Pliers (slip-joint and needle-nose), 4. Adjustable wrench
Combination wrench set Metric & Standard, 6. Socket set- Metric & Standard, 7. Tape measure, 8. Level
Utility knife, 10. Handsaw, 11. Power drill, 12. Drill bits, 13. Screws and nails, 14. Sandpaper,
Paint brushes and rollers, 16. Safety glasses, 17. Work gloves, 18. Flashlight, 19. Duct tape,
WD-40 (or other lubricant), 21. Zip ties, 22. Electrical tape, 23. Wire strippers,
Multimeter (for electrical repairs), 25. Pipe wrench (for plumbing repairs)

A typical Professional Mechanics Belt could include a combination of the following items, this can be heavily influenced by personal preferences and area of discipline.

- Claw hammer, - Tape measure, - Chalk line, - Carpenter's pencil, - Utility knife, - Tin snips - Nail puller, - Speed square, - Measuring squares, - Hand saws (crosscut saw, rip saw, coping saw) - Block plane, - Bench chisels (1/4", 1/2", 3/4"), - Mallet or hammer, - Screwdrivers (flathead and Phillips) - Hand drill or brace and bits, - Wood rasps and files
