## **HUNTING RULES**

## Safety Is Our Number One Priority for Everyone

The following rules and guidelines apply to hunting on N.L.C. G. & F. grounds

- 1. The **only** hunting allowed is **deer** hunting.
- All Pennsylvania Game Laws are to be followed at all times.
- 3. Every effort must be made to **recover game** that has been shot at. There have been far too many cases of hunters not searching for and recovering their deer. Hunters are required by Pennsylvania Game Law to make every effort to recover any animal taken. Anyone found in **violation** of this rule will be **prevented from hunting** on club grounds in the future.
  - 4. **Game cameras** are allowed. We ask that you only use one per person.
- 5. Both game **cameras** and **tree stands** need to be **clearly marked** with the owner's name and contact information.
- 6. While hunting on club grounds all vehicles are to be parked in the **parking lot along**Forrest Road opposite the driveway from the archery range.
- 7. Anyone hunting should **sign the log book** located in the red box hanging in the pavilion. Any **deer harvested** from club grounds **should also be logged** in the red box.
  - 8. Salt licks or other mineral blocks are NOT permitted to be used on club grounds.
- 9. **Rifle range** is **CLOSED for TARGET SHOOTING** but is **OPEN FOR HUNTING** during the first two weeks of rifle deer season.

The padlock combination at the rifle range entrance will be changed for those two weeks.

10. No one should **hunt down range** while the rifle range is **open to target shooting** during any part of the entire deer seasons (i.e. archery, muzzleloader and special firearms).

We understand there may be special conditions and needs of certain individuals hunting on club grounds. Any special requests or arrangements need to be made by contacting the N.L.C. G. & F. Board.
