Reduced Spouse Membership. N.L.C.G.&F. will be offering spouse memberships again this year for \$40 instead of the regular \$50. Information is available on membership renewal form.

We will be holding our **3rd SUNDAY BREAKFASTS AND SHOOTS** starting in March and ending in October as in previous years. We will start serving breakfast at 8:30 AM and shooting events start at 9:00 AM.

**July breakfast and shoot is moved to 4th Sunday 7/26 to accommodate Youth Conservation School*

This is the third year we will be offering **two \$1,000 Scholarships** to high school seniors planning to attend college in the field of conservation. Anyone who wishes to donate to the scholarships can do so by filling in the amount on the donation line on the membership renewal form. Last year an additional \$900 was added to the scholarships from your generous donations. All money donated in this manner will be applied 100% to the students receiving scholarships.

FISHING PASSES will be issued again this year at a cost of \$25. Anyone wishing to fish in the pond will be required to have an N.L.C.G.&F. Membership as well as a Fishing Pass. The only exception is that youth under age 16 will need to have a Junior Membership, but will not need to purchase a Fishing Pass. A valid Pennsylvania fishing license is also needed by persons age 16 and older to fish in the pond.

The **RIFLE RANGE** is a carry in and carry out range with only paper targets to be brought in. Do NOT bring in metal targets. There are permanently installed metal targets which may be used with the appropriate type of ammunition.

The range is maintained by hard-working volunteers. They mow the grass, replace the target holders, target supports and unfortunately have had to clean up trash which should have been carried out by the members who brought it in. Safety for everybody depends upon each and every individual following safe use of firearms and proper personal conduct at the rifle range.

The rifle range is closed for the first two weeks of deer season, during the Lancaster County Youth Conservation School and the Lancaster County Long Rifles event. Be sure to check the event calendar and website for current information and details.

Fishing Rules and Regulation Sign at the pond

01. Please read and respect all rules and regulations.
02. Fishing open only to Members and Junior Members (Age 1-15) Except for the Kids Trout Rodeo.
03. Ages 16-18 must be a Junior Member with a Fish Pass and a PA Fishing License.
04. Non-Members are required to submit an application for Membership.
05. The pond opens to Members only for the Two weeks of trout season. From Saturday through the third Friday. 3 Fish per Day Limit.
06. The pond is closed from the Third week of trout season until the kids trout rodeo.
07. Kids Trout Rodeo: All kids 15 years or younger. 1 fishing rod, 3 trout limit.
08. After Kids Rodeo: Members and Junior Members only 3 Trout daily. 30 trout per season Max. Open to all types of pond fishing bait and tackle. NO LIVE MINNOWS ALLOWED.
09. Pets are permitted in the pond area and must be kept on a leash and under control at all times.
10. Please show membership card upon request.
11. Please abide by all rules and regulations of the Club and PA Fish Commission .
12. Catch and release is for fly fishing only.
