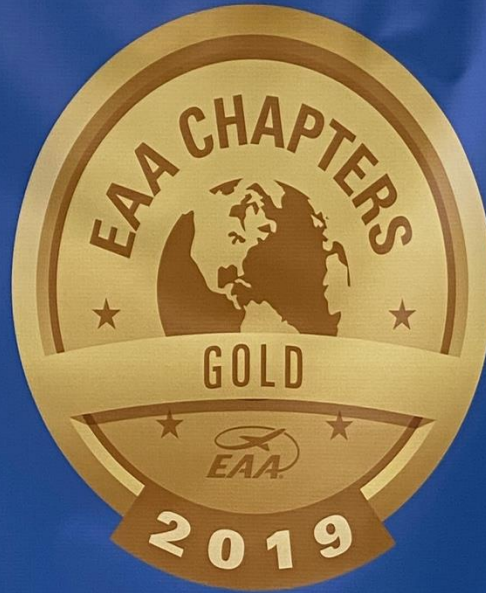

EAA 288 Future

- The Board and I have seen that the long term future for EAA 288 must include a permanent facility
- Spruce Creek rules/environment make it difficult for a chapter to find a home here
- We have been presented with the opportunity to find a new home affordably
- Leasing a facility can allow the gradual transition to a permanent home

The Facility

- A 7700 square foot commercial hangar for lease has become available at 215 Cessna Blvd
 - Large meeting space
 - Small “office” area
 - 60x60 ft hangar
 - Several smaller spaces
- What can fit?
 - Monthly meetings for ALL members
 - Aircraft space for rental area
 - Simulators
 - Small meeting room/theater
 - Project space
 - Workshop space
 - YE briefing space

The Cost

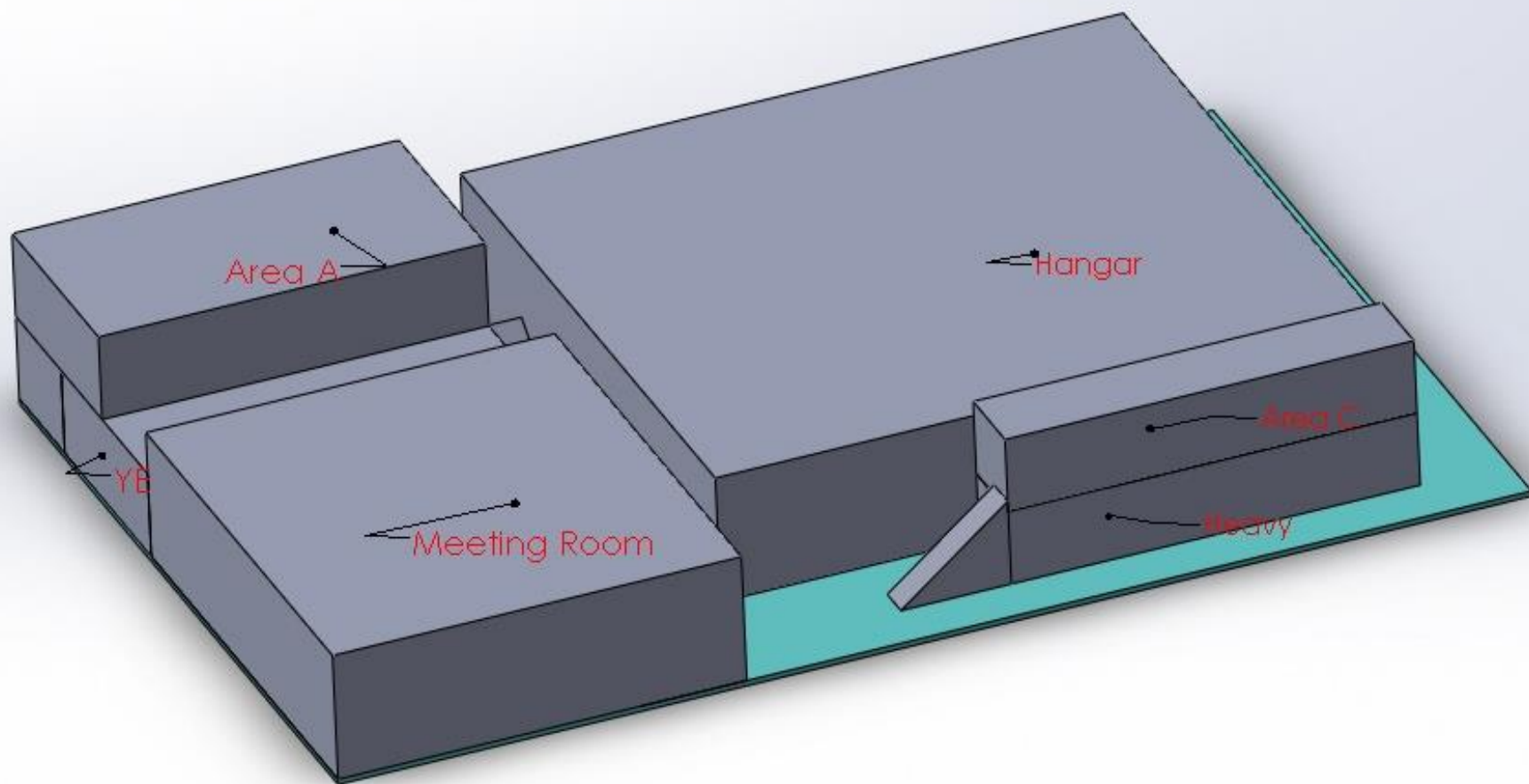
- We will be responsible for Tax, Insurance, Utilities, and other costs. Total cost estimate is \$3700 per month.
 - We can customize the space to arrange it as we like
 - Cost TBD for upgrades, we will wait until the current occupant leaves
- Our resources
 - Member dues
 - Payments from rented airplane space
 - Donations
 - Potential fund raisers

“Game Plan”

- Like all start-ups the first year is the hardest
 - Select EAA renters who want space to rent or work a project.
 - Setup workshop/building space
- Develop a plan for the facility internal space
- Make upgrades per the plan - TBD
- Set up the main meeting area to support monthly meetings first.
- Set up YE area.

Draft Path to operational status

- Ready meeting area
 - Move Curtain, clean facility, setup audio/visual, Internet
- Relocate HVAC line behind wall
- Clear hangar floor, layout parking
- Setup YE area
- Setup “Heavy” area
- Mod area A
 - A/C or Split, walls
- Mod Area C
 - A/c Split, walls
- Move Sims
- Enhancements
 - Social area, pictures on walls, tool areas, donated machines, etc.

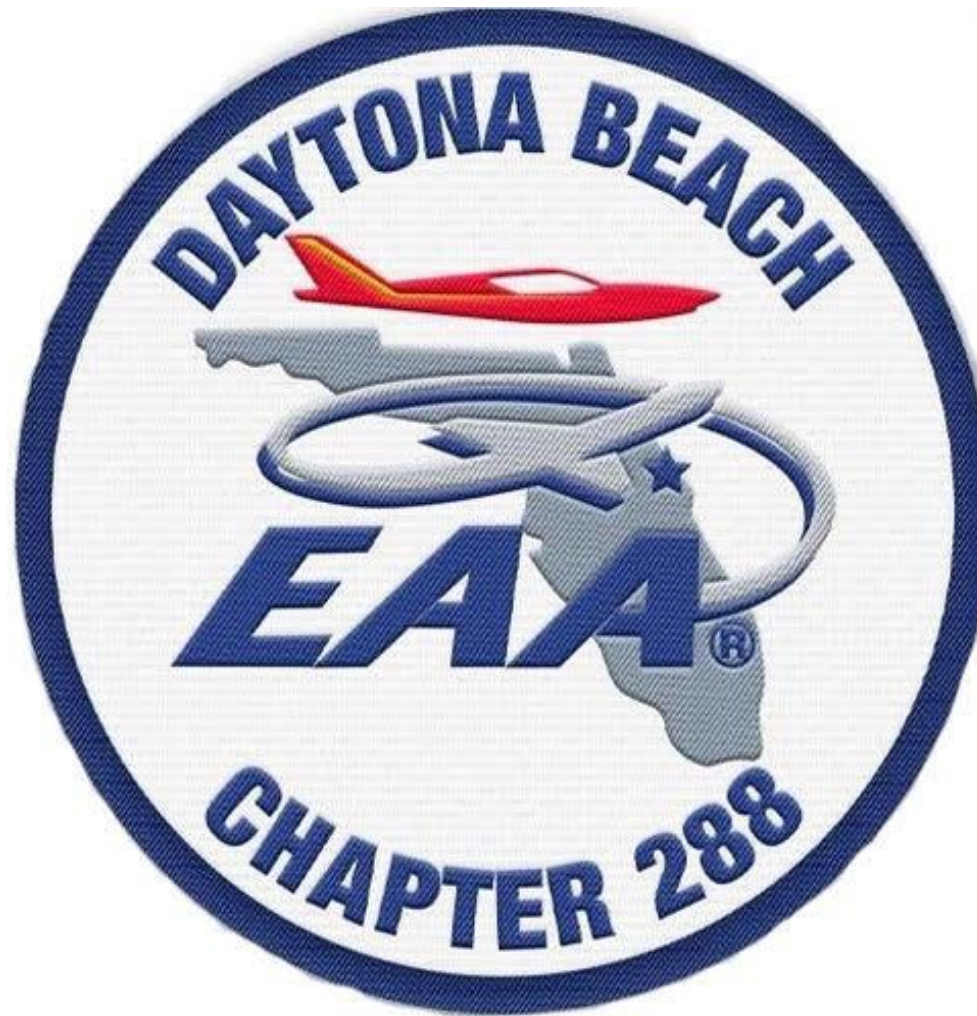
How
