RULES

1. A current Negative Coggins is required at the Secretaries Stand to receive a number.
2. Ridge Road Stables Horse Show committee and the volunteers will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse, or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. Riders must wear a SEI approved helmet while mounted on a horse anywhere on the grounds.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary to make the show run in a timely manner.
5. All dogs must be leashed.
6. The show will run in accordance with current USEF rules.
7. All Equine activities are pursuant to PA Equine Law Act 93 of 2005.
8. No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to a judge without making arrangements with show management.
9. Entries will be accepted on the day of the show until the start of each class.
