### **Flotilla Details: M/Y Catalina**

The lead vessel in the Flotilla is the 130-foot M/Y Catalina ([Sun Dream Yacht Charters](#)).

M/Y Catalina has two spacious decks (air-conditioned main deck + open-air top deck) and will have 400 ticketed celebrants onboard for the Flotilla (certified for up to 516 passengers).

Award-winning [DJ Trevor Oldroyd](#) will give us more reason to celebrate on the top deck dance floor.

Hunter's Nightclub barmen will be familiar faces at the complementary bars, and Sun Dream Yacht Charters will serve a complementary lunch buffet.

M/Y Catalina will board and disembark at the GALLERYone waterfront hotel, and GALLERYone will host a landing party on our return after the cruise.

M/Y Catalina will depart the GALLERYone docks at 12.15pm and return at 3.00pm (see Flotilla Schedule)

### **Flotilla Details: Participating Vessels**

All Flotilla vessels will have their running order number clearly visible on the port (left) bow.

Registering a boat in the Flotilla is just \$30 (to cover event permit costs) – we want as many boats as possible to join the Flotilla and therefore want to keep the participation cost minimal.

The Flotilla will start at the Broward Center/Esplanade Park docks on the New River at **1.30pm on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June** and end in Sunrise Bay.

All decorated boats and crew to be at designated starting dock at Esplanade Park no later than **1.00 pm**, ready to go.

This year the spectacular 130-foot M/Y Catalina will lead the Flotilla down the New River. M/Y Catalina will board her 400 passengers and depart from the GALLERYone hotel dock at 12.15pm and come up the New River (with tugs bow and stern!) to arrive at Esplanade Park for the official start of the Flotilla at **1.30pm**.

Supporting law enforcement vessels (including Fort Lauderdale Marine Patrol, Broward Sheriff's Office, Wilton Manors Police, & Coast Guard) will lead the Flotilla ahead of M/Y Catalina.

We'll assign a starting dock at Esplanade Park for each vessel (see Start Location map).

All vessels must monitor VHF Channel 69 which our very own "Commanderama" (aka Cory Ziman) will use for main communications. Please minimize non-essential chatter on VHF 69 to ensure we can communicate effectively.

The instruction to start the Flotilla will be issued by "Commanderama" via VHF Channel 69.

On day-of-event, "Commanderama" can be reached at 954-470-5673.

We also recommend that vessels monitor VHF Channel 9 (the designated channel for New River / ICW traffic and bridges) and VHF Channel 16.

The Flotilla route from Esplanade Park to Sunrise Bay should take about 60-90 minutes.

The Captain's Briefing Party will be held at Hunters Wilton Manors on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June 6-8pm to give all the information needed for the Flotilla. Attendance by all Captains is mandatory.

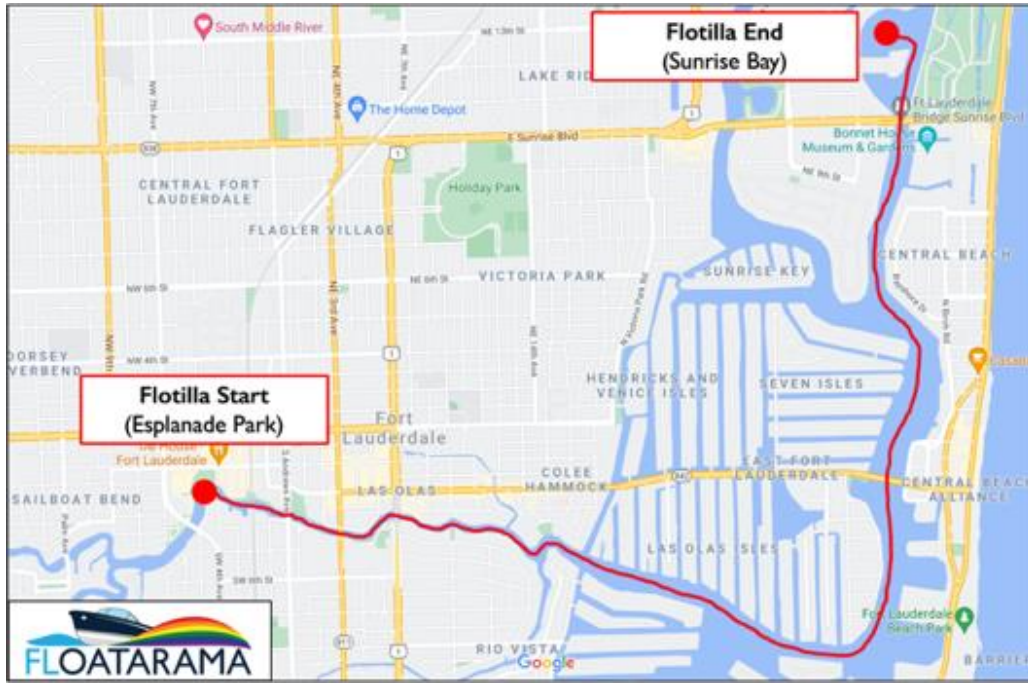

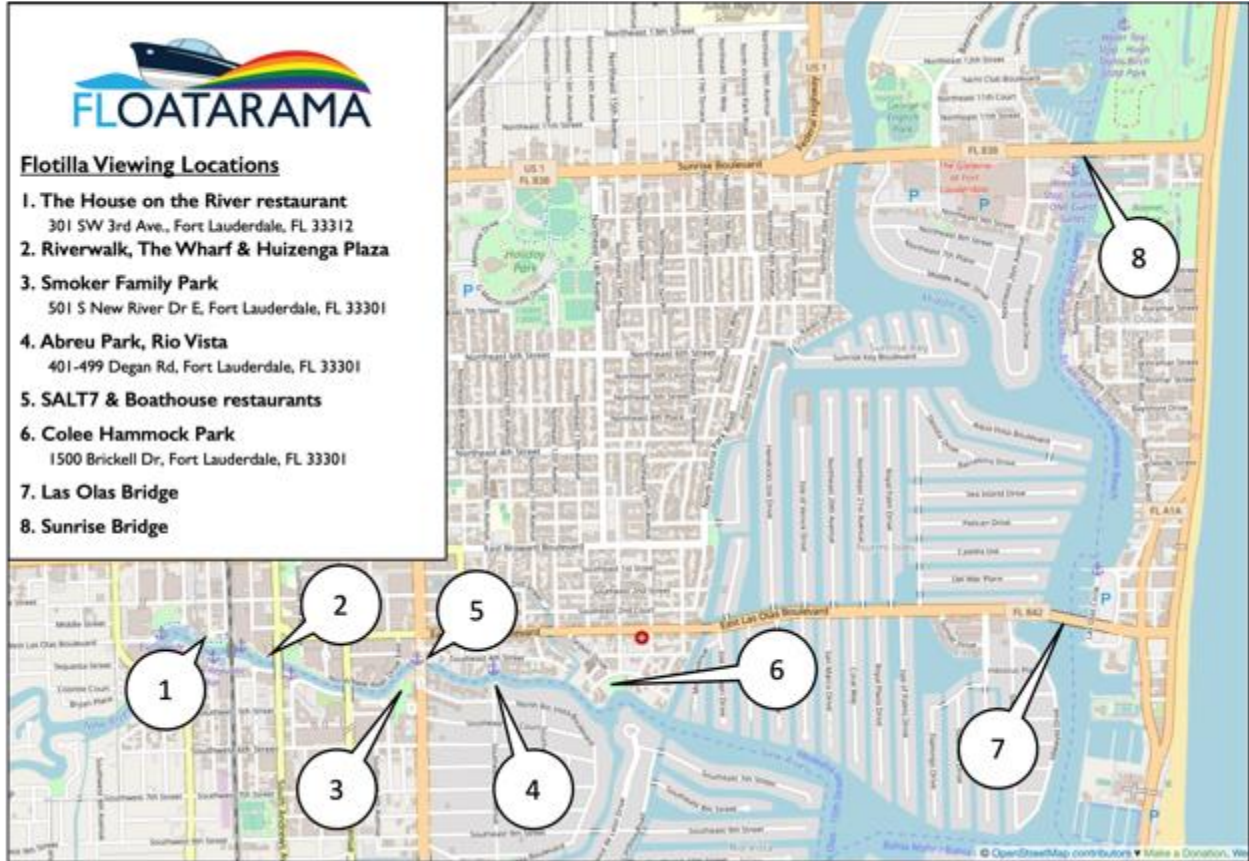

### **Floatarama History:**

From an impromptu start during the COVID lock-down, FLOatarama has grown into a fully-fledged 501(c)3 all-volunteer non-profit organization, with a strong philanthropic focus, and a clear purpose to support at-risk LGBTQ+ Youth.

FLOatarama-2022, the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual event and first under our own 501(c)3 status, was on 11th June 2022. The Flotilla, with Grand Marshal NBC6 Meteorologist Steve MacLaughlin, was followed by the Sailor's Dance & Pool Party, hosted by San Francisco DJ Matt Consola.

FLOatarama-2022 raised \$50,000 for the FLOatarama LGBTQ Youth Fund, benefiting at-risk LGBTQ+ youth (managed by our philanthropy partner, The Our Fund Foundation).

Grants were presented on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2022 to four recipient agencies:

1. South Florida Pride Wind Ensemble (\$10,000 to support Youth Band & Scholarship)
2. YES Institute (\$10,000 funding education on suicide prevention & discrimination)
3. Pridelines (\$15,000 to fund their CampOUT initiative)
4. SunServe (\$15,000 to address increasing waitlist for critical services)

Our first year was spontaneous – an impromptu, socially distanced, grass-roots Pride boat parade of 20+ private vessels during the COVID lock-down in June 2020.

In our 2<sup>nd</sup> year, FLOatarama-2021 included a Flotilla of 34 registered boats, and a sold-out Sailor's T-Dance with legendary San Francisco DJ Matt Consola.

Our Grand Marshal was Fort Lauderdale Mayor Dean Trantalis.

FLOatarama-2021 donated \$17,134 to Pride Fort Lauderdale's GED/Scholarship program.

Our Fund is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest LGBTQ+ foundation in the country, granting \$2M+ annually to worthy non-profit agencies advancing LGBTQ+ causes in South Florida.

Funds raised by FLOatarama go to the "FLOatarama LGBTQ Youth Fund", supporting at-risk LGBTQ youth. The fund is managed by The Our Fund Foundation and directed by FLOatarama.
