

## VIP tickets and boat registration now available for the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual FLoatarama Flotilla, Presented by Hunter's Nightclubs Wilton Manors.

Fort Lauderdale, FL (April 5, 2023) Flotilla registration and VIP tickets for the 4th Annual <u>FLoatarama</u> are now available.

The signature FLoatarama Flotilla will take place on **Saturday**, **June 10**, with 40 boats decorated for Pride departing from Esplanade Park in downtown Fort Lauderdale at 1.30pm and proceeding down the New River and up the Intracoastal Waterway, ending at Sunrise Bay.

Tickets are also available on our VIP vessel, the magnificent 130-foot M/V Catalina, which will lead the Flotilla with Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz serving as Grand Marshal, and 400 celebrants on board. (Note: M/V Catalina departs earlier at 12.15pm from GALLERYone hotel to arrive at the Flotilla start by 1.30pm before leading the fleet downstream).

In 2022, FLoatarama launched the FLoatarama LGBTQ Youth Fund in partnership with The Our Fund Foundation, to support at-risk LGBTQ youth, and awarded four grants totaling \$50,000 to South Florida LGBTQ non-profits. 100% of all ticket sales from FLoatarama 2023 will again go to the FLoatarama LGBTQ Youth Fund.
