Beginning April 16, Lindy's Landscaping will be providing select weekly lawn care every Tuesday, including fertilizer & pesticide treatment throughout the coming months until October.

Please mind the following:

Association's Responsibility:

- Cut accessible grass
- Edge sidewalks
- Mulch & Weed Common Areas only
- Prune only Common Area trees & shrubs

Homeowner's Responsibility:

- Remove leaves/sticks/debris/toys/dog poop from yard
- Mulch, clean, weed garden beds
- Prune trees & shrubs on property
- Unlock & prop open gate for landscaper access by 7AM
- * Failure of Homeowner to take responsibility may result in fines and/or limit responsibility of Association/Landscaper.

Friendly Community Reminders

- ~ Trash/Recycle Cans ~
- Place secured cans out front <u>only on day before</u> scheduled pick-up
- ✓ Store <u>only</u> in rear of house or completely out of view
- ✓ Number your cans for return on windy days

~ Parking ~

- Cars parked in lined head-on spaces (homeowner/visitor) are subject of VOLM Parking Guidelines.
- Cars parked along street curbs are subject of the Borough of Pine Hill parking ordinance.

~ Propane Tank/Charcoal Grills ~

Per NJ Fire Code, all propane cooking devices & outdoor fireplaces must be operated & stored at a minimum of 10 ft from any combustible construction, including the dwelling and deck.

~ Secure Property ~

Home & vehicle burglaries can happen to anyone, at anytime. Be sure to <u>lock all doors & windows</u>. If you see something suspicious or if you've been burglarized, call: the Police & our management,
