DRIVING & PARKING IN OUR COMMUNITY

It's getting more dangerous on our streets

We understand parking is a struggle in our community, but you must keep your neighbors in mind when you park to avoid unwanted frustration and anger and most importantly unsafe conditions for anyone trying to walk on the sidewalks.

- If you are parking on the curb, please be respectful of your neighbors and refrain from parking directly across from driveways or parking spots as it makes it difficult for some vehicles to back out.
- DO NOT park overhanging your driveway onto the sidewalks, this is in violation of VOLM rules as well as Borough ordinances.
- We have noticed an abundance of residents who have assigned head in parking, parking with their vehicle over hanging the sidewalks.

All these issues are causing people to walk in the streets because they can not walk on the sidewalks in the community due to cars parking on or blocking them. People are known to drive way to fast on our streets to begin with which makes it dangerous for anyone walking or riding bikes in our community, but if you are blocking sidewalks, you are forcing people and especially the kids to go into the streets and possibly get hit by one of the speeding lunatics just so you can save yourself from walking a few extra feet. We are just asking that you be mindful and respectful of your neighbors and park properly and even if you are in a rush **SLOW DOWN**.

Due to an increase in some less than desirable behaviors going on at the tot lot, the Board has decided to install security cameras around the area to help keep the play area safe and clean for our little ones.
