As a sister of someone who struggles with addiction, she has a special place in her heart for people in recovery and works with women enrolled in their 6-month program.

Snap-shot of a Healing Service

Most of the clients are in their late 20s and 30s. Many of them struggle with anxiety, depression, fear, worry. These are people. . . they look just like you and me. Their hearts are broken, they carry so much shame and guilt over the things they did when in active addiction. During that healing service, everyone was turning to Jesus. It was a powerful and beautiful night.

When we "debriefed" at the end of the night, one prayer minister commented, "They really don't want much. Just to be free from addiction, to get married, have a child."

We all looked at one another, thinking of all the blessings we have been given - - and how we all want every single one of these people to be able to walk in freedom and have those "simple" things, which aren't so simple for them.

Come Lord Jesus and transform lives with your healing love.

Helping Families Heal

This new LLP program, for families and friends with loved ones in addiction, ran for 9 weeks, teaching all 12 steps and introducing a powerful healing prayer component. One participant wrote, "Helping Families Heal is so clearly God's gift to me. I had no idea how much my brother's addiction was affecting me. I am slowly but surely finding recovery for myself." Another said HFH was, "Giving me hope, knowing that I am not alone, learning technics to deal with the stress, learning about and scheduling my own prayer appointment."

Many found support, "It was so great knowing I have a "family" of sisters who know exactly how I am feeling." I do not feel alone anymore! In a recent time of crisis, I was able to text these women and received support immediately!"

Lasting Truth was revealed, "Helping Families Heal teaches the love of Christ. HFH loves those that are hurting. HFH gives testimony to the saving grace of Jesus. HFH is a safe place for personal discovery and spiritual revelation."


Evening healing services at 7pm are different than Sunday morning church services. We open with prayer, worship, and listen to a short message. Then comes a time of "soaking" in God's love with quiet music playing. Healing prayer ministers move through the sanctuary, listening to people's stories and praying with them. One person said that he felt closer to God than at any church service he attended, because there was time to 'be still' before God and to receive personal prayer. He reflected that he felt alone (in a good way) in God's presence.



The idea for this event came out of our 6-week 'Hearing God's voice class (Mark Virkler's 4 keys to hearing God's voice). This first experience will be for HP ministers and everyone who has taken LLP classes. We hope to fine-tune and then offer it to the public as a powerful way of approaching God.

You might be led to repeat certain parts within the Tabernacle, or to stay at one area for a long while. At 7:15 hear a short lesson on the 4 keys to hearing God's voice. Then choose your own question for God. Find a comfortable spot in the building and journal. Reconvene for a large group discussion and closing prayer.
