Kindness upon kindness has been extended to our family in the weeks since his death. Every single gesture has contributed to the healing of our hearts and has made me realize that nothing is too small, nothing is too insignificant, when we reach out to a fellow human being in need. As we continue to live out our lives on earth, we have no doubt that Scott is doing the same, just in a different realm - with Jesus.

I am so thankful to be part of an organization that brings the hope of Jesus to our community. Together, we stand as witnesses to the Truth that Jesus still heals and delivers people today! His light and love triumph over darkness.

Our 2019 calendar is full of ministry and special events including our 1st healing retreat and our 1st intensive prayer weekend. In January we launched a comprehensive training program with an updated level 1 for new prayer ministers and monthly continuing education classes for all of our amazing volunteers. We also continue to listen, love, and pray with folks in recovery who struggle to stay clean and sober.


