### A Message from the Executive Director

This year, while mulching around sprouting tulips and daffodils, I decided to remove some ugly, knobby weeds. In the past, I had halted their growth by snipping off any visible green shoots, but, now, digging deeply into the soil, I revealed a massive network of thick roots. Using an axe, a pick and a shovel, it took hours to remove just part of this pervasive system. It made me think about the "weeds" in us; strongholds that can keep spreading inside when we only "snip off" their visible parts.

After all this digging-up and chopping-out, the garden was now a bunch of jagged holes and displaced soil. It needed more work to be re-filled, re-planted, and restored; and that refilling made me think of Jesus.

Jesus, the one who suffered and died so that we could live. Jesus, who gave us new birth into a living hope through His resurrection from the dead (1 Peter 1:3). Jesus, whose sacrifice ripped death out by the roots. Jesus, whose love heals our brokenness and restores us to wholeness.

## **God Speaks!**

Many people have questions and want answers from God. The class offered by LLP (*Hearing God's Voice*) sparked my curiosity because there were times in the past, I would pray, hoping to hear from God but would experience zero results. In his book, Mark clearly states anyone can hear God's voice by simply using the following four keys.

- 1. Stillness by quieting yourself
- 2. Vision Looking for vision as you pray
- 3. Spontaneity Recognize God's voice as spontaneous thoughts that light up your mind
- **4.** Journaling Writing down the flow of thoughts and pictures that come to your mind.

Mark was so confident that anyone was able to hear the voice of God that it intrigued me to take the class and see for myself, plus he made it clear if someone did not have a positive outcome, he guaranteed to give them their money back with no questions asked. I thought, that seems like a worthwhile deal. God gave me visions while the words flowed from my mind onto the paper. The results had an amazing impact on how I saw myself versus how God viewed me as His daughter. As I grow in my walk with Christ, I am open to His anointing, knowledge, and wisdom that is in the indwelling Holy Spirit.

During the last session of Hearing God's Voice, we prayed through the Tabernacle, and I asked God why I hesitate to regularly come into this intimacy. God revealed that I never had good human role models of intimacy and (breakthrough moment!) I discovered that our most intimate relationship is intended to be with Him. Our human relationships are intended to "image" the love, safety and intimacy of that relationship, not the other way around. All these years I have been trying to get my relationship with God to a place where my most intimate earthly relationships are, instead of growing intimate with God and then using that love to transform my earthly relationships.

## Rainbow of Love Recovery Foundation

Listen Love Pray Foundation has begun working with mothers in recovery at Rainbow of Love Recovery (ROLR) Foundation! Founder and Executive Director Carleah Summers says she hopes to help mothers get back in their children's lives.

This faith-based organization was founded in 2019 and provides transitional living for mothers recovering from substance use disorders. ROLR offers transitional living to give women a chance to slowly acclimate themselves to life outside of rehab, prepare them for long-term success, and build strong and healthy bonds with their children.

ROLR has 2 transitional living homes in Frederick County and just recently opened a 3<sup>rd</sup> location in Mt Airy, MD! According to ROLR board member Kim Kyle, "there (was) no recovery house... for mothers and children in Carroll County." Ms. Kyle, in recovery herself, adds, "a place where women can work on their recovery *and* be mothers at the same time is definitely an asset".


