Jesus' Glory Reflected on Earth



Take some time to think over the last week of your life. If a photographer followed you for 7 days, what images would be captured? Where are the places you spend your time? How often would your face show a smile or frown? Would the lingering effects of your presence edify those whom you encounter?

In New Testament times, people followed Jesus everywhere, and from the written accounts, a picture of His life and character emerged. Looking at just a few scripture highlights, one can sense the anointed holiness, the tender love, and the servant heart of our Lord.



- Jesus washing the feet of the disciples and feeding 5,000 with 5 loaves and 2 fish.
- Jesus sacrificing himself for us; dying on a cross to take away the sins of the world.

If Jesus lived on earth into his golden years, I could imagine him doing exactly what Dennis Yocum (age 75) is doing in the above picture. Dennis is the Vice President of LLP's Board of Directors. On June 1st, he served communion at the healing service, spent time talking with folks, and finished the night by sitting cross-legged on the ground to chat with LLP prayer minister, Jenny Bonifant.

Our hope at Listen Love Pray Foundation is that we serve others by following the example of the Messiah. No human being comes close to the perfection of Jesus, but some folks sure seem to demonstrate many of His qualities.

“Follow me,” says Jesus to all who place their hope in Him. Christians hear the call to live their lives as Jesus did, not just by saying, “I am intimate with God,” but by walking in the footsteps of Jesus (*1 John 2:6 NLT*). *Ephesians 5:1-2* tells us to be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love. Is it an impossible dream for most of us to become like Jesus?

I hope this edition helps to display the Amazing Grace of God as He works through LLP volunteers whose lives and ministry share Jesus' love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, goodness, faithfulness, and self-control (*Galatians 5:22*).

I was unclear if it was excitement or fear that I felt walking into the arena at Paradise Stables. For certain, I had anxiety rising as they led in the giant, magnificent and beautiful horses and stood them in front of us.

I had no idea what to expect and could never have imagined what the experience would do for me. A simple grooming led me to bonding and trust. The instructors coached me through the experience and as some of my fears dissolved, my heart melted like frozen butter in the microwave. Tears rolled down my face as I was able to fully connect with the horse who I had been most afraid of. I was able to see her and connect almost as a child with her mother.

I will use the new insights to help in my journey of healing from an anxiety disorder. I'm so grateful for this experience.

One Amazing Week of God's Grace

LLP's June Recovery Work



Monday night — Stacey, a resident of Up and Out sober living in Frederick, shared a breakthrough. She talked about the seed of goodness inside her that had turned to anger and hate because of addiction. Although clean and sober for 18 months and participating in weekly LLP Bible studies (as well as other recovery work) she said she finally “let go” as people prayed for her at church, and it was in that letting go that she was flooded with Holy Spirit and *found the healing refreshment her body and soul were longing for (Proverbs 8:3 TPT)*. Stacey described a bondage to fear being broken and then, plain and simple freedom.

Tuesday afternoon — An LLP volunteer offered to donate a car to someone in need. Stacey was the recipient and wrote, “I am still

in shock and filled with so much emotion...I'm so very grateful.”

Tuesday night — During the zoom healing service, participants included a couple of folks in long term recovery who shared the hope found only in Jesus. The worship song *Everything* by Lauren Daigle touched hearts and the truth that **God gives us everything we need** was repeated over and over as people testified to His good works in their lives.

Wednesday morning — The morning recovery team for Beacon House led an hour-long open discussion. Holy Spirit once again moved in hearts, as the men expressed their desire to learn how to pray better, how to relax and how to open their minds. They said that they were tired of hurting others, especially their family members. As the team moved around the room, praying individually for each man, there were tears, healing, peace, laughter, and hugs.

Thursday midday — 2 LLP prayer teams went to the Mount Airy Rainbow of Love recovery home and prayed for two residents. Both ladies stepped into the healing love of Jesus and left, wreathed in smiles with a new lightness in their spirits.


New July Study: Think and Eat Yourself Smart
