LLP Testimony

A Hidden Vow Is Broken: At the Ignite conference, Judith MacNutt spoke about our blocks to healing. One block that Holy Spirit pointed out to me was “hidden vows.” I asked Holy Spirit to reveal to me if I had made any promises that were allowing the enemy to block my walk with the Lord. As Judith’s talk wrapped up and prayer ministers were headed up front to pray for people, I heard a small voice say, “trust.” I continued to pray asking Holy Spirit to come and reveal. I got the sense that I had said sometime in my life, “I will never trust again.” I stood in line waiting for prayer. I could feel His presence. When it was my turn, I said, “I think I said I would never trust again.” I asked for the curse to be broken. As they prayed for me, I felt something rise up in me. I began to cry. I felt something lift off the top of my head. I felt different inside. I felt lighter. I felt hopeful. I felt loved. — LLP Prayer Minister

Inner Healing: I have received much inner healing from Jesus. The Holy Spirit has gone into many of my memories and healed their crippling effects by revealing to me that Jesus was always with me. At Ignite 2019, God had a plan for more healing of my broken heart. As Judith spoke about inner healing, the memory of being abandoned and rejected by my father and subsequent adoption by my abusive stepfather came to mind. When the talk ended and we were given directions for receiving prayer, I asked Holy Spirit which line to go to for prayer. I got the sense that I was supposed to go to the “loss” corner and that I should wait in line for a particular couple of prayer ministers. I told them my story of abandonment and rejection. As they prayed, I could feel deep seated pain leave my body. They prayed for Holy Spirit to fill the hole in my heart. Then they asked me about forgiveness. I prayed for God’s help to be willing to forgive my dad, my step dad and my mom. I returned to my seat and continued to pray. I said, “I choose to forgive.” Another tremendous burden lifted. Praise be to God! — LLP Prayer Minister

Physical Healing

Does God want us to pray for physical healing or are we meant to suffer? A teaching excerpt from the Spring HP2 Workshop:



Francis MacNutt says in Healing Prayer Level 2, “In Jesus (His teaching and actions), we have a new teaching (about suffering). As we see him, Messiah, He shows us that God is, as it were, on our side.

He regards suffering and sickness, as a father or mother would, as an evil (not a blessing sent by God). He ardently desires to free his children from sickness and evil. He passed on his healing power and authority to us, his followers, so that we might, even now, bring the kingdom of heaven to this earth.”

Catherine Marshall in her book, *Something More*, writes about reading the gospels carefully to make a comparative study of how Jesus dealt with sickness and the afflicted. She comes to this conclusion, “Jesus came to earth to reveal His Father’s nature and His will for mankind. Jesus saw sickness and disease as intruders in His father’s world, part of Satan’s work, therefore evil all the way. Consistently, He fought disease just as any dedicated physician fights it.”

One of my favorite bible verses is Luke 10:8-9. Jesus is telling the 72 disciples that he is sending them out in pairs to all the towns and villages that he plans to visit. He says, 1) Eat whatever is set before you and 2) Heal the sick; and as you heal them say, “The Kingdom of God is very near you now.” I believe Jesus wants us to follow His instruc-

tions today! Following the lead of the Holy Spirit, I have witnessed many physical healings.

How shall we pray for physical healing?

Agnes Sanford who wrote *The Healing Light* said, one appeals to the love of Christ for healing. The Holy Spirit brings the healing power of Jesus to believers. When we are open to this flow and follow the instructions that are given, amazing things happen. He uses us to heal others if we listen to Him and trust Him. His light and His power flows through us when we are in His word and repenting and trusting and growing closer to Him each day.

When praying for physical healing, I usually ask the person about the ailment- how long? How much pain? On a scale of 1 to 10 what number are you at right now? Then sometimes I will walk them through these steps to bring them into God’s healing presence. Step 1: Clear your mind of everything. Step 2: Think about God and all He has made. Think about how much He loves us. Step 3: Ask for His healing light to flow into that area of concern. Step 4: Thank Him for what He is doing right now and for what He will continue to do for this person.

We can pray for physical healing on a daily basis. I believe that because the Holy Spirit dwells in us, we can ask for the healing power of Jesus anytime. I think it should just be second nature to ask for healing when a family member is sick or injured. We can all do this with one another. We can even pray for our own physical healing. Praying for healing is just a natural part of being a follower of Christ.

The Ranch Ministry

20 men from *The Ranch* participated last month as LLP's Kristin Nelson led a 3-step lesson filled with activities. "Tonight, the topic is about stepping out of denial and moving forward in your recovery. I learned that I couldn't set a goal and expect myself to be successful unless I identified specific, workable steps that were personal to me. When I work on goals, I have to be real about what had worked for me in the past and what had not... sometimes we want to keep trying to same thing over and over, hoping that it will eventually work.

But if it keeps producing the same undesired result, then we are really wasting our time. We have to step out of denial and try something new in order to move forward in our recovery."

The men wrote down two areas that were out of control in their life. Most of them stayed after the teaching time to talk with prayer ministers about their struggles. Each one received individual prayer, asking the Lord to help with their specific goals. We also had the joy of giving out blessing bags!
