Healed

It's 3:00 am Saturday, March 5, 2022. I wake up suddenly and don't know where I am. As I take in my surroundings, I remember I am at the Hallowood Retreat and Conference Center for the Listen Love Pray Foundation retreat.

Memories of the previous night come back to me. The incredible *talk by Art Thomas about identity*, the joy in seeing all my friends from LLP, and the sensation felt when the Holy Spirit joins the party.

I wonder why I'm awake. After a busy week, I should be exhausted. Why am I lying in bed wide awake? I grab my Kindle with the plan to read myself back to sleep. As I prepare to read my usual secret agent story about murder and mayhem, I remember the retreat theme, "A New Season of Grace." Maybe I should consider different reading material. Hmm, maybe I should read *the Bible*?

I always try to be a good Christian but fail in many ways. I know I need to read the Bible more, but rarely do. As I open the reading list on my Kindle, I am reminded of how infrequently I do. I begin to scroll through the books on the list. Plunder, kill, maim, book after book about violence. *About 6 pages down*, I find the Bible and open it.



Kindle leaves each book in your library where you last read from it. I find the Bible in the book of Acts, at chapter 3. The chapter begins with the story "Peter Heals a Lame Beggar." It tells of a man who is carried by his friends to the temple gate called Beautiful, then how Peter and John provide the man with healing rather than giving him the silver and gold he hoped for. The man, who was lame from birth, is pulled to his feet by Peter, and immediately begins to walk and jump around.

After reading the chapter, I began to reflect on my own life. I'm not sure if I was awake, asleep, or somewhere in between, but I realized I am a lame beggar. That my loving friends at LLP bring me to the Beautiful gate every time I am with them. That Ken and Lucinda Nelson, the founders of LLP, are like Peter and John providing the healing of Jesus. That my time at the retreat is like the time the beggar spent outside the temple. Begging for healing.



I woke up a couple hours later refreshed and ready to continue the healing in A New Season of Grace. I went for a walk outside, found some rocks to climb and discovered a quiet spot to sit and pray. I thanked God for how He has blessed me all my life, and for the revelation I had earlier that morning. I prayed for more as the retreat continues. As it frequently does when I pray, my mind began to wander. In response to my loss of focus, a goose honked loudly at me. After I finished praying, I walked back to the center knowing that He was still with me and had more in store.

A few hours later, 40 people at the retreat joined in Edi's **Prophetic Art** program. We all chose one type of prayer, which determined what type of art we would do. We each did one of a dozen different art mediums; from pencil drawing, to crocheting, to playing music. I painted a rock in response to my request for prayer of surrender. Each type of art clearly become prophetic as the Holy Spirit worked among us.



When we were done creating, Edi brought us all together and explained that our artwork was not for ourselves, but that we would give it to another person. Being the leader, Edi drew the first name and randomly picked me. Edi's chosen prayer led her to the art of writing a story. As she began to read her story she wrote, I realized she had written about the lame beggar in Acts 3. I think Jesus had a message for me. It certainly was not a coincidence that I had come upon the same chapter and verse a few hours earlier. Each participant gave their art to another. Time after time, the Spirit had the right artist share the right art with the right recipient. It was mind blowing.

I write this testimony the following Friday. I can't stop smiling. **My usual triggers do not bother me.** I am able to show patience I don't normally have. I am able to laugh at situations that would typically anger me. I have stayed away from violent books, and have been choosing from the religious fiction genre. I am not only walking and jumping, I am dancing in the love of Jesus. Thank you to everyone who brought me to this wonderful place. *Thank you, Jesus!*
