Post concussion syndrome has plagued me for almost a year and due to the symptoms, I almost didn't make it to LLP's Tuesday night service. The day before, a friend asked if I ever prayed for myself. The topic on Tuesday was 'how to pray for physical healing for yourself'. My heart smiled at this acknowledgment of God's goodness and persistence in drawing me closer. The leader posed a question, "If you could have physical healing that lasted just one week, wouldn't you want that?" My mind responded, 'I would take even an hour of relief.' We entered a time of quiet prayer, yet my ability to open to Holy Spirit barely seemed possible. Anxiety raced through my heart, my head was throbbing, my ears were ringing, tears rolled down each cheek. A prayer minister came behind me, placed her hands on my shoulders, and began to pray. *Immediately, all the symptoms stopped. There was calm. Body, mind, and spirit became still.* In my mind I could see Jesus standing in a boat surrounded by still waters. He had spoken peace to my storm. Praise God. Although symptoms returned in an hour, I have new hope and faith that Jesus sees my struggle and is working for my good.

On May 3, 2023, Ted Winfield, LLP's men's recovery coordinator, sat down with Robert L, a resident in the Changed Life Recovery Program at the Frederick Rescue Mission. According to Robert, the key component that LLP brings to the men is the Joy of the Lord and Prayer.

Recently, during a Sunday LLP program, he told a prayer minister that 2pm was a time of weakness for him. They prayed for him and as a result of that prayer time, when 2 pm arrives, he now has a big smile on his face. It is no longer a problem because Holy Spirit reminds him of the joy felt during that prayer. Robert says he stays in "surrender mode" and that God does all the work to move him forward in recovery. He focuses on Jesus, His love, and serving other people as God's love overflows. His favorite scripture is *Matthew 6:33:* Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be added upon you.

Talkin' about Healing Prayer

Have you ever struggled to describe what '*healing prayer*' is? Have you used the words '*soaking prayer*' and people looked at you funny? Do you want to share healing prayer with folks in your church, family, neighbors, or coworkers?

Anna Lacy was pondering and praying on all these questions as she shared her experiences with LLP in April and challenged us with Paul's encouragement in 1 Thessalonians 2:4-8:

On the contrary, we speak as those approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please people but God, who tests our hearts. You know we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed—God is our witness. We were not looking for praise from people, not from you or anyone else, even though as apostles of Christ we could have asserted our authority. Instead, we were like young children among you. Just as a nursing mother cares for her children, so we cared for you. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well.

Paul, Timothy, and Silas were like Jesus, *loving the folks they were with and simply "doing life" with them.* Naturally, they shared what they loved – the good news of Jesus.

It is common to talk about what we love – our children, grandchildren, pets, hobbies, a new restaurant, etc.

Anna loves healing prayer, so she can't help but share this love with others. For Anna, her sharing comes spontaneously because she works to hold scripture in her heart and build her life around it.

How can we work on this too?

You can ask yourself these questions

- Have I talked to Jesus today?
- Where has God provided for me today?
- How has Jesus' healing helped me in the past?
- Who will I be naturally around today?

Anna also shared these tips:

- Be intentional allowing Jesus to be the center of your heart
- Let His love fill you as you naturally share what you love about Jesus.
- Healing Prayer is a logical extension of the Love of Jesus.

Then, simply do as we do here at LLP, *Listen Love and Pray*. Listen as a person shares with you their current situation. Love them as you listen. And finally, Pray. Ask Holy Spirit what He would like you to say.

Maybe a person says, "I am struggling," "I feel overwhelmed," "I just don't know what to do," or even "I think I need therapy". These can all be openings to share your story about healing prayer.

You can also share your story if someone simply asks, "How are you doing?" You can say "I was feeling this way and having a hard time, then I found healing prayer and now I feel better."
