The river of life, which springs forth solely from the wellspring of heaven, is a direct spiritual analogy to our constant need for conversion of heart and mind to the ways of God's kingdom.

The riverbed is the human soul, without God, it is arid and dry; with all of its needs and wants, it is the very imperfect medium through which the dynamic life of the Spirit flows from eternity back to eternity.

The Spirit-river engages the soul in the life and healing energy of the kingdom, wherein there is total forgiveness of fault and sin, ending in fullness of joy, and real, eternal life.

Although washed in Christian Baptism, the riverbed is still subject to the false promises of the ancient serpent, who constantly lurks along its banks and in its water. If the flow of living love can be diverted, the serpent temporarily succeeds in building barriers to impede the life-giving current; deception establishes strongholds like large rocks, growing on sin and delusions.

Yet, even these seemingly huge barriers can be worn down in time; as the soul, becoming more sensitive to grace, allows the river's flow to increase. The greater flow and force of the Spirit results then, most easily, and without effort, to wear down and wash away these barriers.

What is imperative for the soul in all of this is the deepening ability to recognize where its true wellbeing lies, and thus to surrender to the flow of grace. Swept away by God's authentic love, our frail human needs and wants begin to soften to His vision, and we come to see that we have already been forgiven, freed, saved, healed, and loved.

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Personal River-experiences from The Real Faith

During the February 8th class and healing service, participants spent time "soaking" in the love of God as they allowed His life to flow through them like a river. Here are some of their experiences:

- As I was soaking, I received images of the water cleansing and nourishing, freshening as it flowed. Also, the water was smoothing the rough edges of the riverbed. Then it switched to the riverbed itself. It (me, hopefully) is just lying there totally surrendered, completely at the mercy of the creator/the water. I was created by the water that takes the path of least resistance. —Nancy W.
- Last night during the soaking time, I was aware of an angel hovering in front and above me!!! (1sttime ever!) Itbrought to me a sense of *heaven surrounding me* that was almost overpowering. As I confessed to Jesus, a heart attitude I knew was wrong and asked for help to remove it, the "experience" increased, and I "saw" that particular "rock" in me be powerfully swept away by the force of the river water, clearing the way for the river to flow in a straight path.
- I was reminded of all the man-made obstacles that try to control water but the power of the water, in the end, ultimately has its way. -Ryan

- I was in the water and felt such peace. Then, I saw a huge hand reaching through the water toward me. I knew it was the hand of Jesus, and I said to him, "I'm in the water with you". Again, the hand of Jesus reached toward me. -Susan
- *I* allowed the water to wash all the debris in my life out and make me clean. Then I saw myself standing up and I realized that *I was standing, in the river, on the Rock!* —*Irene*
- I am undergoing treatment for Stage 4 cancer. My Dr. had just told me some of the tumors were dissipating and so, while in the river, I just let the water (of Jesus) cleanse my whole being.

- While allowing His river of life to cover my life (riverbed), I sensed the vastness of the spiritual realm – while – at the same time, I could see and feel "log-jams" that blocked His perfect flow. I pondered the scripture, "set your mind on things above not on earthly things" (Colossians 3:2) and felt the dissonance of living in both a physical and spiritual realm. I realized in a deeper way, my need for the constant flow of Jesus. —Lucinda

We join our voices and give thanks and praise as written in *Psalm 106:1 "Praise* the Lord, for He is good! His faithful love endures forever."


Upcoming Book Study

He Delights in Me

I live out of state but wanted to have a Zoom healing prayer session with Listen Love Pray because I realized that there is some inner healing needed in some areas of my life where I would like to experience more freedom. For me, these sessions have been like planting seeds and tilling the soil. It's awesome when the Holy Spirit moves quickly and noticeably but I find that, at least in this season of my life, God responds in a different way. He allows the seeds that I planted while seeking him in the inner healing session to sprout if I continue to take the time to meditate on them (or *water* them, if you will) in my own personal prayer time.

During one session, the team prayed the Father's Blessing over me. It was comforting, but I wouldn't describe it as "having an encounter with God" or "feeling the presence of God", both of which I am familiar with. During the prayer, there was something that stuck out to me, it was something about *no longer blaming my earthly father* for his shortcomings. I made a note of it, we finished the Zoom call, and I left encouraged.

A few days later, I was spending some time with the Lord and meditating on this idea of no longer blaming my earthly father for his shortcomings. I found myself in an inspired conversation with the Lord as a little girl, maybe 8 years old. In this vision, I was in a small ice cream shop with the Father, and I was somehow aware that every flavor of ice cream that I could ever want was there! I started to get overwhelmed with the reality that I could not eat all of the ice cream! I could sense the Father encouraging me to pick three flavors, and as I started choosing them, somehow I knew that each one of them had a meaning and was a reference to different seasons in my life. Each flavor spoke to the main themes of three different seasons in my life.

It was so nice to feel like a little girl, loved and safe in my father's company. *I knew that I was welcomed, I knew that I had his undivided attention, and I know that he was enjoying our time together more than I was. He delighted in me*, and he delighted in the bliss that I felt while I was with him there in the ice cream parlor.

It was whimsical and personal and lovely. I am still working through some areas that I want God to transform but it is always encouraging to have God meet you where you are along the journey.

For months I had been wresting with the idea of making a private healing prayer appointment. And every time, I would come up with some excuse as to why the timing wasn't right. I now realize that JESUS doesn't need a "formal" invitation, no matter the circumstances. And, if you need prayer, simply ask! There is no doubt that Holy Spirit was in the hallways, and at work at Beacon House that night, not just for the men but for me! Thank you, JESUS! And, thank you, Lucinda for asking and caring!
