

Jesus Heals Today

photographed this painting in a chapel in Israel. This image has just stayed with me. It shows the encounter with Jesus of the woman who had a bleeding disorder for twelve years. This story is captured in *Matthew 9:20-22*, *Luke 8:42-48*, and in my favorite version, *Mark 5:24-34*.

The version in Mark is my favorite because it provides much more context about what the woman experienced in the twelve years she had suffered this disorder ...under the care of many doctors, spending all her money, but she just got worse. How many times at Listen Love Pray Foundation have we encountered people who have experienced suffering for years, seeking the healing power of Jesus?

As Mark's gospel shares, this suffering woman is in a crowd of people following Jesus, and she simply believes ... she has faith ... that by touching His garment ... not even Him ... but just by touching His garment she will be healed. Imagine being in a crush of people, just trying to get close enough to Jesus to just be able to touch His garment. This painting shows that moment, when Jesus' healing power is supernaturally transferred to the woman, and she is immediately healed. How powerful is that?! The faith this woman had! She struggled for 12 years ... 12 years ... to be healed, and after exhausting all her resources, turned to Jesus for that healing.

At Listen Love Pray Foundation we are extraordinarily blessed to encounter the healing love of Jesus in so many ways. These encounters happen during private healing prayer appointments, our prayer services, our classes, working with the recovery community, and simply when we ourselves spend time soaking. Jesus confirmed for this woman what we know and experience ... that Jesus heals today!

Mark 5:24-34

A large crowd followed and pressed around him. And a woman was there who had been **subject to bleeding for twelve years**. She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, **yet instead of getting better she grew worse**.

When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, because she thought,

"If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed."

Immediately her bleeding stopped, and she felt in her body that she was **freed from her suffering**.

At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked,

"Who touched my clothes?"

"You see the people crowding against you," his disciples answered,

"and yet you can ask, 'Who touched me?"

But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it.

Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth.

He said to her,

"Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."


