I'm learning to guide hurting people to fix their eyes on Jesus in a private healing session. Never did I imagine in 1,000 years that I would be serving God in this way. I was once too shy to even utter a prayer in front of any one but Jesus revealed His gifts to me and how He wanted me to use them. And in doing so, I have been able to witness miracles. I am blessed to be a part of LLP and excited to see where Holy Spirit leads.

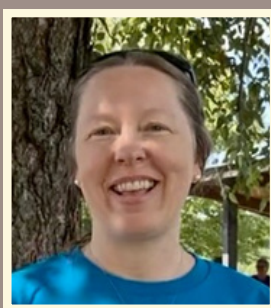

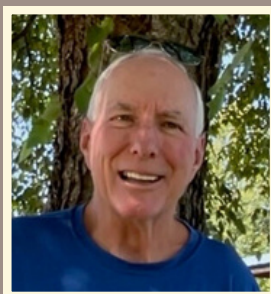
2026 healing conference is June 25-27

I want to relay an experience we had at the Something More conference last June in Shepherdstown. A family attended whose daughter was missing. They were so distraught and we prayed for both the husband and the wife throughout the entire conference. You could tell that they had a strong belief in God, a strong belief in the power of prayer and it was just so wonderful to see the Holy Spirit fill them up during the whole conference. After they came home from the conference on a Sunday, that next day their daughter came back home! We know the power of God and we know the power of prayer. It touches people and it is real! *Bruce*

At the September 30th healing service we talked about energized prayer. James 5:16 (TPT) says tremendous power is released through the passionate, heart-felt prayer of a godly believer. "Effective fervent prayer is a deep Spirit-led prayer that is energetic and not routine" said Zion Presbyterian Church. "The indwelling Holy Spirit wants to help us find meaning and energy in prayer."

After the message, we quieted mind, body, spirit in a time we call "Soaking", fixed our eyes on Jesus and tuned to Holy Spirit. Suggested question: Lord, what do You want to say to me about finding meaning and energy in prayer? Irene shared what Holy Spirit revealed to her.

The meaning of the prayer is about who I (God) am and what I want to do in your life and for those you pray for. The energy, I provide through the Holy Spirit by the power of My resurrected Son, Jesus. So, continue to know this truth in all situations and for all needs. This is such an important part of my plan for you to grow in Christ, until the day of Christ Jesus.

Walking in the Light



But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. 1 John 1:7

The phrase, “walking with God”, or in “the light” refers to the way we live our everyday life. This continual, intimate relationship is not just a brief encounter to ask God for whenever we need at the moment. It is a communion where we are aware that every breath, every heartbeat, every blessing we receive comes from the Source of all life. But, how can we navigate through the ups and downs, twists and turns but still walk in the light – in deep spiritual union with God? If we walk in the Light, two things happen.

1. We enjoy **intimate fellowship (deep spiritual union)** with our fellow believers who are walking in the Light.
2. We experience continual cleansing of our lives because of Jesus.

An article in Active Christianity said,

“Where the light shines new growth comes. Love, joy, kindness, long-suffering, and all the fruits of the Spirit grow in the light”.

Paul indicates this type of spiritual growth when he writes, “for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light for the fruit of light is found in all that is good and right and true.” Ephesians 5:8-9.

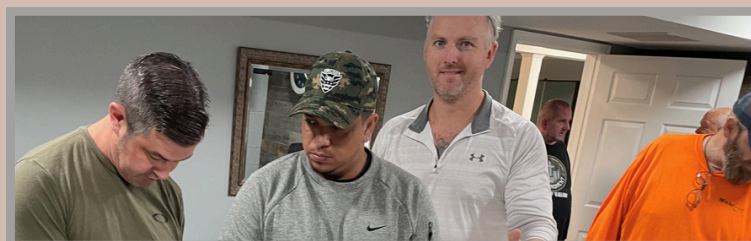

The lovers of God walk on the highway of light, and their way shines brighter and brighter until they bring forth the perfect day. Proverbs 4:18 TPT

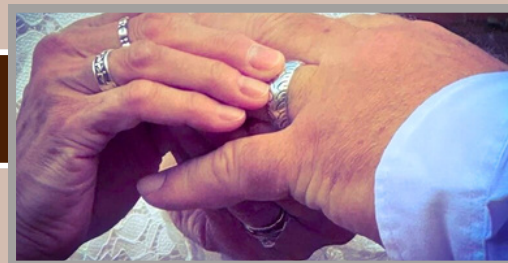
Our God is so personal. He is always beckoning to us through His beautiful illumination within our minds and spirits. All glory to Him!

A sampling of the interactive experience is below. Complete these at home to seek God's wisdom and knowledge for your marriage.

- How do you want to treat Jesus? (Write answer) How do you treat your spouse?
The way you treat your spouse, who bears Christ's image, is the way you treat Christ. P 84 Matthew 25: 34-40. Instead of pressuring your spouse to self-sacrifice, model self-sacrifice. Since we become what we behold, show your spouse a consistent lifestyle of self sacrifice so they can behold Jesus. But don't play the martyr. Real self-sacrifice requires nothing in return.
- Do you want your spouse to change?
Many people want their spouse to change, so they critique behavior, complain about each other's incompetence, and generally express disappointment. Refuse to define your spouse by their failures. Our expectations color our perceptions. Sinful judgments cloud our discernment and make us fall victim to offense when none was intended. P 154
- Ask the Lord to give you His heart for your marriage. Write down what you feel God wants for your future together. Be cautious not to slip into the trap of defining who you wish your spouse would be. Instead, write about the person you already know them to be, the potential you already see in the two of you, and the sort of impact you would love to make and legacy you would like to leave for your children and in the world. Take time to pray that God would work out His vision for your marriage.
