Work Hours:

- 84 hours per bi-weekly pay period
- Day shift: 6am – 6pm & Night shift 6pm – 6am
- 12-hour shifts
- Every other weekend off
- All staff rotates from days to nights & vice-versa, every 14 weeks

Duties:

- Ensures the safety & security of detention residents
- Provides direct supervision
- Thoroughly documents resident behavior
- Processes resident intakes & releases
- Patrols housing areas (completes 15-minute surveillance checks)
- Escorts residents throughout the building
- Maintains facility cleanliness
- Collects toxicology specimens
- Conducts welfare checks on new residents to ensure they are not injured
- Searches residents by completing a “pat down” search
- Uses general communication, computer and writing skills
