Background

- Measure T is a 1/2 % Sales Tax for Roads in Madera County
- The current Measure "T" will expire in 2027
- The proposed Measure T on the November 5, 2024, Ballot is a new 20-year extension and would take effect in 2027.
- The 1/2% sales tax has been around for 30 + years, but with questionable results.

We Recommend a NO Vote Because:

Past Flaws have NOT been fixed:

Bait and Switch on Road Projects

- Critical Tier 1 projects identified in the 2006 Measure T Ordinance have not been completed. Money was reallocated to Tier 2 projects without voter approval
- Cancellation clause was removed. There is no provision to cancel the tax if voters are not satisfied
- Jurisdictions at their sole discretion can shift funds from local roads to regional projects
- Expenditure plan says Jurisdictions can move money around without citizen review;
 BUT the Ordinance says they can't. Which is it . . . Can, or Can't?

• Insufficient Public Engagement

- Same decision makers as in the past
- Decision-making board needs to be made up of both elected people and citizens

Negligible Impact on Road Conditions

O After 30 years, our roads remain in the bottom 5 counties in the state.

Safety Issues Not Addressed

 Egress Fire evacuation routes have not been given the highest priority. More funds and attention are given to new developments and businesses than roads in high fire danger areas

Lack of Transparency and Dark Politics

- Polling in early 2024 indicated that the Measure was expected to fail. SO, County Decision Makers resorted to Dark Politics. They:
 - Hired a sub-consultant specializing in campaigning (illegal)
 - Collaborated with sub consultant to lower voter approval threshold to win at any cost.
 - Overrode good-faith efforts of Citizens Steering Committee to retain control.
 - Falsely claim citizens wrote ballot language and Ordinance. They were written by Staff.
 - Hide funding sources and donors from voters with secretive organizations



There is another opportunity in 2026 to get it right!
