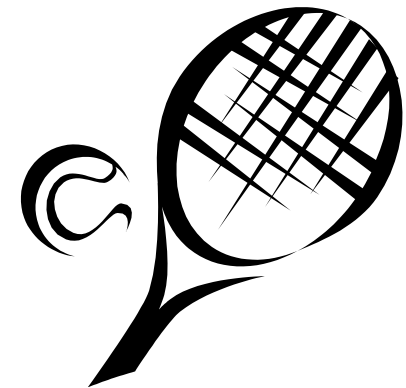

The Tennis Camps @ Wake Forest

The Tennis Camps @ Wake Forest University offer tennis players of ALL ABILITIES, ages 6-18 (rising 1st graders through high school graduates), the opportunity to work on their games under the tutelage of Coaches Tamer Hegazy (Lead Instructor for tennis camps at Wake Forest since 2001), Andy Roland (Associate Head Women's Tennis Coach), and Jeff Wyshner (Head Women's Tennis Coach). Camp utilizes the world class tennis complex that is home to both the ATP Tour's Winston Salem Open and the Wake Forest tennis programs. The camp emphasizes a game-oriented, fun learning environment while giving the technical instruction and repetition required for tennis improvement in combination with singles and doubles match-play. The camp is open to any and all entrants (limited only by number, age, and grade level).

Limited Availability

Camp enrollment will be limited this summer to approximately 40 campers in the morning and 48 campers in the afternoon. PLEASE SIGN UP EARLY.

Air Conditioned Courts

Wake Forest Tennis Camps make use of 8 indoor, air-conditioned courts and 13 outdoor courts. Due to Covid protocols, we expect to use the outdoor courts more frequently in Summer 2021 though the indoor courts remain available for our use as needed.

Overnight Camps

There will be no overnight camps in summer 2021. We hope to return to offering overnight camps in summer 2022.

SAMPLE DAILY SCHEDULE

8:45-9:00 AM – Morning Drop-Off
9:00-9:15 – Warm-up and Attendance
9:15-12:00 – On-court instruction, drilling and play for our younger campers.
12:00 – Morning Group Pick-up
12:15-1:15 – Courts closed for sanitation
1:15-1:30 – Afternoon Drop-Off
1:30-1:45 – Warm-up and Attendance
1:45-4:30 – On-court instruction, drilling and play for our older campers.
4:30 – Afternoon Group Pick-up

Drop-off and pick-up will be at curbside. This year, the driveway to the courts will be one-way traffic only during this time. Adults will remain in cars at all times.

MORNING SESSION

The morning session is for campers who will be at least 6 years of age by August 31, 2021 through rising 7th graders. Experienced, tournament players who will be 11 by August 31, 2021 will be considered for the afternoon session on a case-by-case basis. Rising 6th and 7th grade campers who play on middle school teams are expected to attend the morning camp.

AFTERNOON SESSION

The afternoon session is for campers going to 8th grade or higher in Fall 2021.

VACCINATION RECOMMENDED

Wake Forest Athletics and the Wyshner School of Tennis strongly encourage all campers to become fully COVID-vaccinated before attending camp. By vaccinating, campers protect themselves and others from the COVID-19 virus, and campers can avoid being contact traced and/or quarantined if exposed.

TUITION

\$275 per session

A \$25 discount per session applies to all sessions when signing up for 2 or more sessions whether the sessions are for one child or for siblings.

There is a group discount of \$25 per camper for high school or middle school teams that sign up as a group. Please contact the camp director for more information.
