

Oregon Trail Rough Riders Annual Activity Requirement

Every Member over the age of 18 with an Individual Membership, and each Family Membership, must complete an Annual Activity Requirement of 12 hours of volunteer work in order to maintain membership. Families may choose to divide the Activity Requirement amongst themselves. **In lieu of the Activity Requirement**, all Memberships may choose to pay an additional fee, due upon joining or renewing a membership, based on \$10 per hour not to exceed \$120 annually. At the end of the year, Memberships will be assessed a fee for any unworked hours based on the rate of \$10 per hour. For example; Six (6) unworked hours x \$10/hour = \$60. **The fee for any unworked hours will be due at the time of renewal for Membership the following year.**

There are many ways to fulfill this requirement without paying the In Lieu of Fee. In addition to participating in scheduled work sessions, Memberships may perform a variety of activities. The following is a list of some examples;

Adopt a Bay for the year and maintain it

Be a dedicated brass picker at a shoot

Help set up and take down targets for a shoot

Write stages for a shoot, subject to final approval by the Board

Serve on the Board of Directors

Be a dedicated score keeper for a shoot

Perform an approved administrative function, approved by the Board

Solicit donations for Fundraiser events

Set up lunches and help clean up at Fundraiser events

Pick up and deliver lunches

Be a dedicated Loading/Unloading Table Safety Officer at a Fundraiser event
